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




Store Heifers to £1470

Incorporating our Third Autumn 2024 Show and Sale of Continental bred store cattle

400 head of store cattle on offer again this week here at Exeter and although we didn't see them any dearer, those on offer still did look very well sold. Steers topped at a very creditable £1730 given form a super pen of four Charolais (28m) from Nigel Baverstock of Doddiscombsleigh with a trio of younger (23m) Charolais bullocks from Alan Hembrow, Lostwithiel of high quality just a bit back at £1720 apiece and even younger ones (17m) again of high order from David and Wendy Holland, Dolton coming back at £1580. Several consignments of well-bred and summered British Blues about again this Friday when strong, classy steers (18m) ran to £1650 and £1640 David and Wendy Holland again whilst Simmental steers also saw Nigel Baverstock returning to part with one (27m) for £1595. David and Wendy Holland sold Limousin steers (22m) to £1570 whilst perhaps one of the highlights of the day was a fine run of mostly Limousin bred stores from the Bickle Family of Bridestowe who saw the better of their Limousin steers (21m) reach £1570 and British Blondes (18m) to 1520. Hereford steers (24m) sold on behalf of Geoffery Parkman in from Stoodleigh eased to £1530, these were followed by grand Aberdeen Angus steers (28-30m) firstly from Nigel Baverstock at £1510 then three from Alan Jewell of Okehampton drew £1480 apiece. Much younger Angus steers (18m) from WJ Berry and Son of Kenn saw their best sell to £1475 whilst Geoffery Parkman saw a strong (24m) Montbeliarde steer (24m sell at £1300. Onto the heifers when it was Charolais all the way, starting with bunches (22m) from Alan Hembrow realising £1470 and £1430 then David and Andy Mortimer, Sowton Village saw one (24m) rack up £1420 whilst David and Wendy Holland saw their pen of four smart Charolais females (18m) reach £1380. A lovely British Blonde heifer (18m) from the Bickle Family easily made £1375 with Limousins with same favourable comments and born around the same time and from the same good home reached £1340 apiece for a pen of three. Very decent British Blue females (21m) from the Rowe Family of Two Waters Foot rose to £1310 with others close (24m) at £1300 for David and Andy Mortimer whilst Alan Jewell saw his best Aberdeen Angus heifers (28m) make £1285. Hereford heifers (18m) topped out at £1150 for the Bickle Family.

Suckler bred types and well presented dairy bred types continuing to meet strong demand. Steve Arrowsmith-Brown of Postbridge topped the section with South Devon steers achieving £960 (12m). HB & PR Chattey down from Cullompton showed Angus steers (9m) that levelled out at £800 whilst the best of the dairy bred types saw Ross Crang of Dulverton see his Blue steers (12m) release £700 with tremendous younger dairy bred types off the same good farm racing to £660 (6m). Young Charolais cross steers from PA Ford of Chulmleigh hit £630 (6m) which Hereford steers to £590. Heifers topped out at £805 from Steve Arrowsmith-Brown for a super bunch of South Devon heifers (12m). A sweet pen of Simmental cross heifers from JHR Southwood of Copplestone levelled out at £700 (8m) whilst young Limousin heifers (6m) from NM Sanders of Camelford achieved the same figure. Dairy bred Blue heifers from Ross Crang topped out at £630 (12m) with further dairy bred Blue heifers this time from Baulch Partnership levelling out at £500.

A market of very young fresh milk calves on offer at Exeter on Friday which saw a varied trade. Bulls topped at an impressive £380 for a very young but sweet Simmental bull sold by MR & KM Pring of Broadclyst. More Simmental bulls made £290 for KG & SRL Wotton of Dittisham & £290 also sold by RM & CM Govier of Exeter. Super Limousin bulls to £360 in from MJ & MJS Saunders of Hemyock, others to £250 for MA & EJ Bennett Ltd from Broadhembury. No superstars in the British Blue section but the best bull reached £278, £270 & £245 presented by MWJ & SJ Gould of Whimple. Others to £242 from M Broom of Wilmington and £230 for JLH Vallis in from Bradninch. Angus bulls sold away to £220 & £290 for Yendell Farms of Morchard Bishop. Hereford bulls to £175 & £160 (x2) for fresh types in from JD Musgrove of Yealmpton. Top price in the heifer section was £245 for a smashing fed Limousin in from MJ & AJ Saunders. Simmental heifers to £200 & £195 for MR & KM Pring again and Blue heifers to £232 & £225 for M Broom and £220 for MJ & AJ Saunders. Friesian bulls reached £134 for young sorts in from Yendall Farms with others to £50 for AR Hopper & Son of Spreyton.

1932 STORE LAMBS

Another busy Friday with good numbers in all sections and trades just similarly as strong as recent weeks. Just a few short of 2000 store lambs were a mixy show of generally longer term lambs and lacked the top end sorts, a few less buyers too after last week's packed alleys and trade maybe a pound or two less, in line with the prime returns. That said an average of £97 for the quality forward was a very pleasing result and all lots competitively bid for throughout. Top money of £130 to K Vallerius of Luppitt as Tony Frnacis of Okehampton made £125.50, the Stanbury family of Looe had a smart run that peaked at £125 with another 3 pens at £121 and £121.50, £125 also for Alan Cottle of Bratton Fleming and Twitchen Farm Partners rose to £124.50. Numerous other pens of short keep lambs from £118 to £122 and medium keep lambs this week usually £105 to £115 but some staler coated and leaner things possibly back under £100 with small longer term sorts usually £78 to £95 with only the riff raff, (of which there were many) less than that.

136 GRAZING EWES

Grazers to £119 for a Suffolk cross from Tony Pickard of South Molton as Chris Southcott sold two Whitefaced Dartmoor type rams at £106 and plenty of others from £90 to £100 and pretty much all genuine lean grazers on parade here today.

73 BREEDING EWES & 18 STOCK RAMS

A very mixed but not disappointing show of breeders today with rams commanding a premium for the decent quality forward, topped by Steve Dennis of Bow with Texel's at £600 and £500 whilst his older brother Clifford Dennis of North Tawton sold Charolais at £410 twice and £400, Jilly Handley of Sampford Courtenay made £400 and £320 twice and The Rolle Texel flock of Okehampton sold a Texel at £250. Breeding ewes maybe slightly harder work with Paul West of Holbeton making £165 of his last Mule shearlings for the season, Robert & Christine Steer of Avonwick had Badger faced cross shearlings at £138, K & J Services of Bovey Tracey had Mule 4T's at £135 and Tony Pickard sold Mule FM's at £130 & £120

14 PEDIGREE HAMPSHIRE DOWN FEMALES

The annual show and sale of Hampshire Down females on behalf of the sheep breeders association saw a tight entry sell well in front of a good crowd of local and travelled buyers and bidders as well as a tremendous contingent of buyers on Marteye that saw 8 of the 14 sold, selling to buyers on Marteye and travelling to Wales, Scotland and all across England.

Three sheep shared the top price of 1150gns (£1207.50), two of these being twin bearing shearlings from the Yarcombe Flock of Henry Derryman and Family of Yarcombe who also exhibited the Overall Champion sheep of the day, another shearling scanned for a single that realised 900gns. The other at 1150gns came from John Harrison down from Mid Glamorgan and this time was an exceptionally well bodied FM ewe, scanned with twins and having bred many successful show sheep herself. John also topped the Ewe lamb trade with his best at 520gns, 480gns, 420gns and 400gns as Rob & Sue Small of Liverton sold strong ewe lambs at 450gns and 420gns and Buglegate Livestock of Stourport on Severn sold their shearling ewe at 300gns as well as ewe lambs at 275gns and 250gns twice


