




Store Steers to £1740 Store Heifers to £1580

A slightly indifferent entry of store cattle (quality wise) this week, with many runs of poorer bred and weathered sorts on show, although they did see a much stronger trade than those normally meet at this time of the year. On saying that, amongst another entry of over 400 head of stores penned and sold here at Exeter there were still plenty of excellent cattle to report on with keen demand once again for them too . Store steers topped at £1740 given for a trio of grand Hereford bullocks (24m) from Ian Serpell of Plympton who also saw a pen of four strong Aberdeen Angus steers (24m) rise to £1710 apiece. Other Angus bred steers of note included a lovely bunch of six younger (18m) suckler bred ones from Alan Eustice of Exbourne which drew £1300 a life. A high quality run of South Devon steers (18m) from Steve Kitt up from Saltash looked well sold when topping out at £1725 as did smart British Blues (24m) at £1680 for lan Serpell and £1540 for Roger Calcraft of Aylesbeare. Charolais next up when Graham Lethbridge, Diptford parted with a couple of eye catching sorts (28m) which rose to £1650 each followed by a super run of younger (18m) Charolais steers from Richard Brayley in from Jacobstowe with bunches fetching £1600, £1570 and £1560. Simon Heywood of Bolham sold three tidy Limousin steers (24m) for £1480 apiece followed by later born Limousins (14m) at £1305 for KJ & SC Grabham of Northlew and shapely yearlings came back at £1280 and £1240 for Jonny Barton Jayne of Kingswear. The store heifer section was headed by Charolais, firstly with three head turning sorts (28m) from Graham Lethbridge which made a very creditable £1580 each followed by another bunch of three (18m) with the same favourable comments at £1500 apiece for Richard Brayley. A pen of five, fine British Blue heifers (24m) from Ian Serpell ran to a decent enough £1430 whilst the same seller parted with a strong Simmental (24m) for £1400 and further Blues (23m) eased to £1330 for Simon Heywood who also sold a pair of cracking Limousin bred heifers (24m) for £1300 a life. Younger (14m) Limousin females sold readily and to £1120 for KJ & SC Grabham. Best of the Hereford bred heifers came in the way of a smart pair (24m) from Ian Serpell again and returned £1255 whilst Aberdeen Angus (20m) realised to £1090 for GI Merchant and Son of Ashburton. Also, a trio of good Stabiliser heifers (18m) from Nigel Gribble of Launceston made £930 each. Just a few Organic registered cattle on offer this week with the best of them, an Aberdeen Angus heifer (24m) from James Shevington up from Harbertonford selling to £1180.

A yarding with very little quality forward met trade brisk throughout. Top of the day saw Simmental cross steers (7m) from JHR Southwood of Copplestone fly to £770. Campbell Hill of Torpoint presented Charolais cross steers which achieved £735 whilst young Stablizer steers from AR & HC Radmore of Sheepstor obtained £650 (6m). JA Ayre of Giles in the Wood presented dairy bred Angus steers (12m) which realised £650 whilst similar Blue steers from Charlie Hutchings of Bradninch hitting £640. A consignment of served & bulling heifers from Messrs E Gay & Sons of Axminster from their Walkabout Herd sold well to a top of 1380gns x 2 & 1350gns for spring calving heifers with the best of their bulling heifers to 950gns for a group of 4 whith other groups to 880, 870, 830 & 820gns. Mike Windel & Family consigned a group of 11 pedigree Ayrshire bulling heifers from their Wroughton herd in Wiltshire to a top price of 780gns with others 730gns & 720gns. Organic crossbred heifer calves sold to a top of 350gns for Maundrill Farm Partnership of Highbridge.

A super entry of pedigree Jersey youngstock from three breeders sold to an overall pleasing trade. Top of the day was 2500gns for "Mydrim Victorious Shot Of Love Tara" by River Valley Victorious from the noted Tara Family going back to Gaddesden, she sold due I December to Kev & Sian Rickard for their Starlet herd. Richard Saxby & Family sold a consignment of youngstock from their Saxown herd to a top price of 2100gns for "Saxown Victorious Heidi" again sired by River Valley Victorious this heifer from the great Heidi Family sold due in November to Messrs GA Dean Ltd of Dorset. The same buyer bought two more in calf heifers at 1200gns for "Saxown Explore Éclair" and "Saxown Ferdinand Cash 132". The best of the yearling heifers topped at 1100gns for "Saxown Addiction Cash 141" by Rivermead Casino Addiction, this super calf is a granddaughter of the great Saxown Precision Cash 89 EX94 and she sold to the Davis Family for their Rivermead Herd. The Davis Family of Tiverton sold a consignment of 17 heifer calves from their Rivermead Herd with a top price of 900gns for a three week old heifer calf "Rivermead Addicted To Dancing" by Rivermead Casino Addiction, this calf was from the Lets Dance family going back to Rapid Bay and she sold to her excited new owner Phoebe Lawrence for her Knightsview herd. Other heifer calves sold to 850gns for July born "Rivermead Addiction Kestrel 2", this super calf by Addiction was backed by 6 generations of VG or Excellent dams and sold to Graham & Marjorie Rudd and Kerry Scott of Cumbria. Other month old calves made 600gns & 450gns with the consignment averaging well at £528.

IMPRESSIVE LOFORD PEDIGREES IN DEMAND

A good company of buyers, including a strong contingent from South Wales, were drawn to Exeter Livestock Centre by the impressive catalogue for the dispersal of Michael, Joanne and Rob Wade's Loford herd of Holsteins, removed from their farm near Bideford. The majority of the animals were descended from many generations of animals classified in the top two grades with many boasting 5 or more generations Excellent.

The top price of the day was 4,600 guineas given by David Jones for Loford Legend Gloria to join the renowned Wiltor herd just over the Severn Bridge in Monmouthshire. This very smart VG-87 2 year old in her first lactation is bred from 4 generations Excellent, tracing to a cow bought at a Sterndale Sale more than 20 years ago. David was in again at 4,000gs for a similarly classified heifer by Stantons Chief from the famous Flo Family.

Another VG 2 year old Loford Artist Lustre, tracing to the famous Canadian show cow Idee Lustre, will be staying in Devon, purchased for 4,100gs by Messrs Hussell for their Perrins herd at Shebbear.

Loford Appeal Rae, recently classified Ex-91 in her third lactation, will be heading to West Wales, bought by Gareth Thomss for the well known Gelliddu herd, near Carmarthen. Another on the Welsh load was the top priced served heifer Loford Alpha Divine, who made 3,700gs, purchased by Mark and Caroline Davies, who had bought several choice animals in the previous week's Gatrog dispersal. This outstanding jet black heifer, in calf for December with a sexed heifer calf by M-B Luckylady Bullseye, was out of an Ex-93 pointed cow from the outstanding Dellia Family, who was sold for 3,500gs and heads to the Crystalclear herd in Yorkshire.

As they had done at the Gatrog Sale. the heifer calves met a lively trade, selling to 2,100gs for a 3 month old Lambda daughter from the Fifi family, purchased by G.Jenkins, of the Caran herd, Talybont.

The whole sale returned an average of over £1,900 per head, a very satisfactory figure considering there were quite a number of older cows in their sixth lactation or more and many of the calves were under two months of age,

1622 STORE LAMBS

Not just as many sheep this week with around 1900 forward and sold with the 1622 store lambs meeting a fiery trade, considering the fat trade and as a few buyers have filled up over the last few weeks and drifted away, today we saw a flurry of bulk seasonal buyers, with lorries to fill. A single Dorset ram lamb topped the trade at £140 for Paul Rowden of Blackawton going to fatten and other pens of forward stores sold at £139.50, £133.50, £133 & £128.50 for Peter Heard and family of Okehampton with sizable well framed shorn sorts, as Becky Moody of Exeter sold her pen well at £127. Plenty of lambs trading £120 to £125 for Messrs Lloyd of Bovey Tracey with nice skinned Charollais lambs and some pens of medium keep well bred shorn lambs commanding a premium and often selling in the late one teens. Several "O" grade lambs on offer today and looking well sold given their prospects with it not taking much of a lamb to exceed £90. Longer term tidy lambs usually all £80 plus but some pens of hill bred lambs and some riff raff here today meeting with more resistance. Overall average of £96.50 is just 50p less than last week.

158 GRAZING EWES

158 genuine grazers sold to £125 for a Suffolk x ewe from Roger Alford of Sourton, £124 & £110 for Messrs Middleton of Asreigney and £102 for a monster Easycare from West Emlett Farm of Black Dog. The Collins family of Cornwood sold two pens of two tooth Badger Faced Welsh Mountain wethers at £92 and £89 whilst leaner smaller and lighter ewes were back from that but all competed for well from the 7-8 farmer and processor buyers.

82 BREEDING EWES & 13 STOCK RAMS

A sizable entry of breeders that in honesty lacked superstars sold to £124 for Charollais cross shearlings from Mike Tozer of Totnes as ME Stevens & Partners of Okehampton sold a large pen of young Texel x ewes at £117, a price matched by Alan Jewell of Okehampton with FM's who had other pens at £115 and £113. Rams in stark contrast to last week's flyer met a steady trade with Bonner Farms of Umberleigh selling a Charollais shearling at £340 as well as two Suffolk's at £280 and Paul Rowden had a 6T aged Dorset at £140.

7 EWES & 13 LAMBS (20 LIVES)

First of the season's ewes with lambs at foot saw Fiona Farmer of Cullompton part with 4 mixed aged ewes with 7 lambs at £240 per outfit (£87.28/life) and doubles with younger lambs at £205 (£68.33/life).
