Store Steers to £1645

Store Heifers to £1360

Decent numbers of stores forward again this week here at Exeter, and nothing wrong with the trade either, with plenty of buyers about looking for both those grazing and yarding. A trio of top quality South Devon steers (24m) from Chris Lentern of Chagford back again for a second week and selling to a top of £1645 apiece followed by later born South Devon bullocks from (18m) at £1560 for JP Matthews and son up from Torpoint and yet younger (16m) ones of high Class from Dave Lockett and Family of Cornwood which drew £1490. Best of the South Devon heifers ran to £1310 (26m) from Rob and Sue Greep from Cornwood with others a little older, close at £1305 for Anthony Rew and Family up from Newton Abbot. Back to the steers where we saw several excellent runs of British Blues peak at £1600 for a smart, strong one (22m) from Rosie Fishleigh in from Sourton Cross followed by a pen of five more sturdy Blues of the same age sold on behalf of Colin Burrough of Axminster at £1460 a life and a further single from Andrew Bending from Hittisleigh which also came back at £1460. Well grown younger Blues steers (just 10m) from Andrew Cullen, Exeter saw his pen of five return him a creditable £1120 apiece. More young store steers (15m) from Peter Hendy of Staddiscombe, Plymouth eased to a pleasing £1510 for his pair of British Blondes whilst Blonde heifers sold away to £1145 for a pen of three (20m) from the Perryman Family of Black Dog. Aberdeen Angus steers(22m) saw £1480 for a couple from Penny Hanson, Widecombe in the Moor and £1370 for seven (20m) sold for David Parris and Family of Upottery who also parted with top selling heifers of the day when their pen of six Aberdeen Angus (20m) reached £1360 each. Other Angus heifers worthy of a mention included a trio (23m) fetching £1210 for Penny Hanson again. Martin Jarvis in from Chawleigh sold his smart Salers steer (26m) for £1300 whilst Limousins (22m) from Andrew Bending were just a bid or two back at £1290. Plenty of quality Limousin heifers about with cracking ones (28m) easily making £1360 for Rob and Sue Greep followed by younger sorts (24m) off the same farm at £1260 and others born around the same time making £1250 for Geoff and Marie Sharam of Dartmouth. Simmental (16m) and Hereford (22m) steers from John Southwood from Black Dog and Geoff and Marie Sharam respectively both drew £1110. Best of the rest in the heifer section saw Dave Lockett and Family back when selling their Stabiliser (21m) for a decent £1320 and Keith Watkins in from Puddington saw a Hereford heifer (24m) rise to £1000. A few grazing cows about again this week and all selling well with the very best coming from Geoff and Nicky Arscott of Chagford with a young Salers cow reaching £1240.

Another wonderful trade here at Exeter with Angus steers (12m) from the Thomson Family down from Pennymoor topping out at £990 with younger types to £820. Richard Langdown from Molland presented a lorry load of Charolais x steers (7m) hitting £970 (x2) with others to £940 & £790. Josh Webber across from Yarcombe presented Blue dairy bred types (11m) which levelled out at £955 with others to £860 with younger bred dairy stirks from Peter Rogers up from Ashprington topping out at £750 for Charolais' (7m) with Limousins levelling out at £700. Heifers topped out at £910 for Charolais' (7m) from John Shears of Chagford. The Thomson Family attained £890 for Angus heifers (10m) with others to £810. Richard Langdon saw his Charolais x heifers (11m) achieved £880 with Limousins off the same good farm to £840 and younger Charolais x heifers (6m) achieving the same figure. Charolais dairy bred heifers (8m) from Peter Rogers topped out at £740 for GFL Dairy down from Templeton saw their Blue heifers (10m) level out at £600. Small selection of Bulls forward topped out at £530 for Limousin crosses (7m) from Luxton & Ridge in from Coldridge.

A small but quality entry of rearing calves forward on Friday at Exeter saw plenty of interest with plenty of competitive bidding ensuring another very pleasing trade. Top call was £420 for a very well reared Angus bull presented by Gibbins Agriculture, Clyst Hydon who sold others to £395. More Angus bulls reached £320 for FJ Luxmore & Son, Lapford & £260, £255, £242, £235, £228 & £218 for young Angus bulls all from MF Yendell & Son, Morchard Bishop. Best of the Blue bulls topped out at £355 for JW & LF Baker, Exeter who had others to £305, others to £275 & £270 for DW Cole & Son, Bradninch. Limousin cross bulls for the Horton Family, Roborough sold well at £320, £305, £300 & £290 a real credit for their quality run. Young but decent Charolais bulls sold to £300, £282, £275 & £260 for JH & M Simmons, Poltimore. 1 Hereford bull forward which sold fantastically well

to £310 at only 3 ½ weeks old. Reared Angus' topped the heifer section also for Gibbins Agriculture selling to £350 & £310. More Angus' selling well to £230 for LA Luxmore & Son, Crediton and £190 for MF Yendell. Blue heifers well in demand with tidy sorts to £280 for JW & LF Baker, more to £255 for DW Cole & Son again and £255 & £250 for G E Ellett & Sons, Littleham. In next was a superb run of Limousin heifers from the Horton Family again which sored away to £250, £248 & £240. A young Longhorn heifer made £130 for DW Cole & Son. Friesian bulls still in very strong demand topping at £126 (x2) for MF Yendell & Son.

A huge entry of dairy cattle saw a cracking trade from start to finish. A small number of fresh milk topped at £2000 for a super pure Normande heifer from Peter & Helen Hawkins of Worcester who sent five lovely heifers down with others making £1950, £1850 & £1650 to average £1774! A Norwegian Red heifer from Dave Hunt of South Brent sold well at £1800. Friesian cows sold to £1650 for How Now Dairy Ltd, Ugborough.

The Dispersal of 280 Youngstock on behalf of Messrs LJ Goaman & Sons of Bideford sold very well throughout. In calf heifers for the Autumn were quite an exceptional trade topping at 1900gns twice with others to 1880gns x 2, 1850gns x 2, 1820gns & 1800gns x 4 as well as numerous heifers making between 1600-1800gns. Heifers due the end of the year looked the best value on the day but still sold readily. Bulling heifers met strong demand topping at 1300gns for a smart heifer bred from the Lila Z family going back to Willsbro. Other groups of bullers sold well to 900gns, 880gns, 840gns, 820gns & 800gns with many more between 750-800gns. Yearling heifers saw the best groups to 5750gns with most between 600-700gns. These cows mostly had superb spring born Charolais calves at foot and were in great demand! A quiet day in the sheep pens for the opening sale of store lambs with many potential vendors busy with grass harvest as well as cautious to see where this season's trade kicks off. Up some £23 on the year is the answer with an overall average of a few pence short of £100 and many many more could be sold to an audience of local and travelled farmer buyers. Medium lambs generally either side of £100 with forward sizable but by no means fit to kill lambs trading in the £120's and £130's with a top of £156 for a single lamb from Luke Bulley of Chudleigh who had another at £129. Richard and Angela Smaridge of East Allington sold their best pen at £132 as Malcolm and Edward Pring of Broadclyst sold their two pens at £121 & £116 and £166 also for T Elson of Okehampton. Martyn & Catherine Chudley of Harberton saw the best of their nice stores sell at £109 and £104 and Ray Tucker of Bridford sold his best at £105.
