The strong Autumn store cattle trade continued at a pace here at Exeter on Friday with a mainly high class entry of both suckler and dairy bred steers and heifers selling in front of a host of buyers and to as well as we have seen at this time of the year. Charolais steers led the way in that section with tremendous pairs (24m) reaching £1950 and £1850 for Nick and Margaret Lugger of Modbury followed by later born Charolais bullocks (17m) at £1790 for Barry Mildon and Family of Cadbury and further standout ones (19m) selling to £1620 and £1610 for Alan Hembrow up from Lostwithiel. Leslie Bryant in from Crediton with a lovely run of Aberdeen Angus steers when parting with a sturdy single (19m) for a creditable £1840 and a trio, slightly younger (17m) for £1580. Plenty of those well summered British Blue steers about again this week with an eye catching pen of six (18m) from Barry Mildon and Family rising to £1675 and four (24m) from Maydown farm Ltd from Bridport realising £1620 apiece together with a couple of that age easing to £1450 for Michael Tooze of Broadsands and younger (16m) Blues to £1200 for Matthew Wilson of Dunsford. Martin and Karen Curtis of Elburton Saw their eye catching British Blonde steers (20m) easily reach £1540 whilst smart Limousin bred bullocks drew £1510 for both Keith White and Family of Sandford and Nick and Margaret Lugger. Best of the Hereford steers (24m) came from Maydown Farm Ltd and reached £1320 and Devon bred bullocks (18m) returned £1250 for TP and KJ Welch of Awliscombe. As with the steers, the heifer section was headed by high quality Charolais when Nick and Margaret Lugger were back selling theirs (22m) to £1580 and £1470 followed by more fine Charolais (21m) from Alan Hembrow at £1470. Frank and Martin Saunders of Templeton were back for a second week selling smart Limousin cattle and saw four heifers (18m) make £1410 with others (22m) at £1320 for Keith White and Family, also, more cracking British Blonde cattle from Martin and Karen Curtis saw a trio of delightful heifers (21m) run to £1380 with British Blues (24m) not far back at £1335 for David and Mary Stark of Denbury. Hereford heifer (28m) came back at £1290 for Aimee Mogford in from Nomansland followed by a couple of spirited Bazadaise (25m) from Colin Drake of Dunsford at £1210 apiece, also, Devon heifers (30m) ran to £1200 for Wadhayes Farm Partners of Awliscombe and Aberdeen Angus (28m) picked up £1140 for both Devon Granite Ltd of Pennymoor and Michael Kelland in from Chevithorne. Just a couple cows and calves on offer this week with Bazadaise outfits with young heifer calves at foot reaching £1570 for Colin Drake whilst grazing cows topped out at £1390 for a shapely Devon from TP and KI welch.

2609 STORE LAMBS

A big day in the sheep pens with nearly 3000 head forward and sold comprising of 2609 store lambs, 130 grazing ewes, 195 breeding ewes and ewe lambs and 11 rams. The largest show of stores for some time, possibly this year sold to a decent enough trade, given the number and the fact a few bulk seasonal buyers were missing this week. One or two fresh buyers in attendance though certainly helped, as well as fresh vendors from near and far coming to experience the Exeter store market for themselves. Nearly twenty pens of lambs over £120 selling to a top of £135, achieved twice by Trina Owens of Lympstone with sizable ram lambs as John Quick of Coldridge sold a big pen of forward lambs at £129.50, Mark and John Moore of Rackenford reached £129 with their best and John Gilbert of East Allington made £126. Graham Cole and Lizzie Robson up from Lewannick sold a cracking run of shorn continentals to £124, £122.50 & £121.50 as Brian Cawsey of Torrington sold two pens of strong Texel crosses in their wool at £123.50 & £123 and Peter & Janet Rogers of Sydenham Damerel sold nice shorn Texel crosses at £123. Plenty of shorn lamb on offer again today and some could be back £5 to £8 on last weeks flyer seen especially for shorn lambs but in general prices were very similar across the board. Not many hill lambs forward today but several last draw tiny tots meeting limited demand from £30 to £60 and all included in the overall average of £96.90 which is 86p less on the week.


