Prime Cattle to 282ppk & £1714 Barron Cows & Cull Bulls to 212ppk & £1790

A much reduced Bank Holiday entry of prime and cull cattle sold readily again this week with finished steers topping at £1714 (618ppk x 278ppk) for Adrian and Bradley Bowden in from Drewsteignton with a British Blonde followed Limousin bred heifers off the same farm which eased to £1542 (548kg x 282ppk) and £1476 (530kg x 279ppk). Barren cows rose to £1463 (692kg x 212ppk) given for a smart Charolais from Richard Player of Thorverton whilst the best of the South Devon Barreners came from David Ponting of Modbury which drew £1371 (698kg x 197ppk). The better of a couple grand Simmentals from Paul Rowden up from Blackawton realised £1353 (754kg x 180ppk) and Aberdeen Angus cows saw £1274 (702kg x 182ppk) firstly for Richard Barter and Family of Bovey Tracey then one sold at £1235 (700kg x 177ppk) for Charlie Horton of Stoke Gabriel. A striking, young (50m) Simmental cull bull from Andrew and George Palk of Marldon came back at a creditable £1790 (1038kg x 173ppk).

2107 PRIME SPRING LAMBS

With more than 8000 sold over the four Mondays in May trade has inevitably dropped back somewhat since the start of the month. No bigger drop today than expected though with an SQQ of 385ppk back some 22p on the week, 56p on a fortnight ago but still some 50ppk in front of the corresponding week last year. The heavier lambs and better fleshed, fed sappy sorts less affected with some weekly vendors within a pound or two of last weeks returns.

Overweights to £221 for Alec Vanstone of Shebbear who also had penfuls at \pounds 190 twice, \pounds 210 for the pick of Ellen Yandle of Oxton's Suffolk cross Mules as 55kg singles sold at £209 for both Anthony Elsworthy of Witheridge and Michael Down of Payhembury and Glynn Priddus of Woodbury Salterton sold a pen of this weight at £206. A smart trio of 53kg lambs from Trevor Selway of Sidmouth claimed £208 or 392ppk as the best of Oxton's Tom Yandle's sold at £205.50 and £203. A super 50kg Texel lamb from Rob White of Tavistock rose to £207 (414ppk) whilst Andy O'Brien of Exeter sold patiently fed 50 & 52kg lambs at £201.50 & £201, similarly Keith Pook of Galmpton had solid 49kg lambs at £201. Richard Yabsley of Dartmouth made £200 of 48's as FR Jarvis of Copplestone sold the pick of his 47's at £200 and more of this weight at £192 for both Trevor Selway and Milborne Wick Farms of Sherborne. 46kg Suffolk cross lambs sold at £185.50 for John Simmons of Poltimore as 45's realised £180 for both Anthony Elsworthy and Tracey Quick of Cullompton with 44's also at £180 for Messrs Comont of Copplestone. 43's at £176.50 for the Retter Family of Cheriton Bishop as smart 42's peaked at £178.50 (425ppk) for David Churchill of Axminster as Michelle Churchill and Family of South Chard topped the market per kilo with real plummy 41kg Beltex cross lambs at £177 or 432ppk. Other 41's at £172 for the Morgan Family of Kingsbridge and 40kgs to £169 for Julie and Ed Williams of Ilsington. Some smart lightweights holding up well with both Deane Hurford of Axminster and Martins Farming of Dunkeswell exhibiting shapely 39's at £165.50 with Deane also having 38kg Beltex crosses at £158.50 and a double pen of 37kg lambs from Geoff

and Nicky Arscott of Chagford sold at £153.50. Plenty of smart lambs trading top side of £4/kg but the staler coated and leaner unfed lambs proving much harder work today and pulling back the averages. SQQ 385ppk, overall average of 383ppk or £164.80 per head equating to a drop of £5.20 per head on the week.

687 PRIME HOGGS & 262 MATURE SHEEP

Still nearly 1000 old season for the last week in May, in contrast to 457 for the same week last year. Quality very few and far between today though and trade harder work on all but the very best. These very best sorts included a fine run as always from Martin and Adam Crabb of Luppitt who exercise patience and precision when drawing prime hoggs and their mainly continental 53to 63kg sorts sold readily in penfuls at £221.50, £218, £216, £213 and £210 (x3). Other smart overweights at £221 for S Harler of Buckfast and £220 for J Baker of North Devon whilst the more common sorts were either side of £3/kg. 50-51kg hoggs to £175 (x2), £174.50 and £174 for the Burrough Family of Chard as Marshay Farm of Pennymoor sold similar at £174, Paul Trant of Halwell had 49kgs at £168 and Edward Hosegood of Zeal Monachorum sold 47's at £162. Medium weight hoggs a more variable trade with a tidy double pen of 43kg's from SF Langworthy of Sidmouth realising £150 as similar weights from Brian Webber of Cullompton achieved £148. 42's to £137 for the Bailey Family of Dorset, 41's to £131 for Graham Parker of Burrington and a tidy pen of 38's from Rob White of Tavistock traded at £120. Mature sheep reached £200 twice, with the bulk of them either side of £3/kg with lighter and lesser sorts back from this but still pounds in front of mainstream deadweight results for mature sheep.

1429 CULL EWES & 45 RAMS

Numbers and trade holding steady with this the third week in a row of selling mid teen hundred ewes and averaging £130 something. A generally decent show of ewes but like the lambs there's still plenty of leaner and plainer ewes coming forward trying to catch the trade and because of the large numbers of these, their trade is certainly no faster. A single Texel ewe from Gareth & Jess Hutchings of Launceston topped the sale at £288 as the Ken Family of Exeter sold continental ewes to £240, £200 and £196, both Peter Rideout of Chettle and Kevin & Becky Matthews of Launceston reached £230 with Texel's and Charollais respectively and Anthony Carter of Dawlish sold a Rouge ewe at £222. Plenty of other continental pure and crossbred ewes either side of £200 with the best of the Suffolk cross ewes reaching £196 for the Hansford Family of Honiton, £192 for Phillip Colwill of Whitestone and £190 for both Dan & Emma Kirk of Ashwater and Tom & Steve Hammett of Broadclyst. Numerous pens of heavy crossbred ewes selling in the £160's and £170's with leaner, half meat crossbred ewes typically £125 to £150. Mules into the £140's for a few choice pens and plenty £125 to £135 with leaner half meat sorts £85 to £105. Hill ewes with flesh well chased with the Abel Family of Tavistock selling a large pen of Scotch ewes at £95 with other Scotties at £90 for Matt Wreyford of Blackawton and Welshies at the same money for Greg Hutchings of Launceston. Tups a solid trade but lacking the top end with Rob Webb of Crediton selling a heavy Dorset at £178 ahead of Three Valleys Livestock of Cerne Abbas with similar at £165 and Anthony Carter parted with a pair of Roussins at £160, a price matched by John Quick of Coldridge.
