A super yarding of well over 400 head of store cattle here at Exeter this week, some no doubt drawn by our latest Autumn show and sale of continental bred stores, Trade motoring on for all types and every bit as dear as we have been seeing them and big numbers leaving the south west again. Steer topped at an impressive £1800 given for a grand Charolais (24m) from Sue and Sean Cleave of Moretonhampstead whilst later born (15m) Charolais saw a smart trio from Rosie Fishleigh, Sourton Cross reach £1500 a life. Strong Aberdeen Angus bullocks (20m) from Roger, Jill and Giles Ford in from Knowle, Crediton up next when their eye catching pen of six eased to £1695 with younger Angus (16m) still rising to £1440 for Charlie Ellis of Roborough, Plymouth. Simmental stores in abundance this week with a forward single (25m) drawing £1650 for Matthew Bailey from Morchard Bishop and a pen of three (17m) from George Hill of Tavistock making £1580 apiece. British Blue steers (25m) topped out at £1620 for Andrew Burrough of Wellington followed by Limousins, firstly from Matthew Bailey at £1590 (22m) then three (18m) from Nathan Janes of Weston- Super-Mare which saw £1570 a life. Very well bred and farmed yearling Limousin steers ran to £1520 for Jonny Barton Jayne of Kingswear. Sue and Sean Cleave back when selling South Devon bullocks (25m) to £1535 together with a couple of super ones (15m) from Richard and Angela Smaridge of East Allington which returned them a creditable £1450 a head. Further native breed steers saw a shapely Beef Shorthorn (18m) rise to £1520 for Nathan Janes and five big Hereford steers (20m) from Roger, Jill and Giles Ford fetched £1500 each. Onto the store heifers when Sue and Sean Cleave parted with a lovely Charolais (22m) for £1440 and Keith Chapple, Cheriton Fitzpaine sold five Charolais (18m) for £1255 apiece whilst Simmental females (22m) ran to £1390 for Roger Calcraft of Aylesbeare and George Hill saw his best (16m) realise £1190. Nathan Janes back when selling a single Stabiliser heifer (17m) for £1360 followed by the best of the many British Blue heifers on offer firstly at £1290 (22m) for Roger Calcraft then three (20m) from Gary Harding up from Blackawton picked up £1280 a life and a lovely bunch of five Blues (23m) from Hazel Cheriton, Cheriton Fitzpaine reached £1240 each. Will Coleman, Lapford sold a super lorry load of strong stores and saw his best Hereford heifers (17m) fetch £1280 whilst Stephen Downing, Diptford parted with his better pen of four Herefords (25m) for £1250 each, also, Limousin heifers (26m) hit £1270 for Trevor and Mary Wilson of Kingston, Kingsbridge. The latter also saw an aged (42m) Friesian female draw £1170 and Aberdeen Angus rose to £1160 (28m) for Charlie Ellis and £1090 (18m) for Stephen Downing. Just a few organic registered cattle about this week with a standout bunch of nine Devon steers (16m) making £1250 apiece for Bannadon Farm, Okehampton whilst Top priced grazing cows were £1295 for a pair of decent Angus from Charlie Ellis

Two and a half thousand sheep here today and a real buzz to the sheep pens with fresh faces both buying and selling in pretty much all sections. Just a few shy of 2000 store lambs and what a trade from start to finish on pretty much all classes of lambs to leave an average of £102.27 for a fairly mixed show. Best lambs £130 for Alistair and Thomasina Wilmington of Branscombe who had another three lots at £127.50, Mel Cawley of Beer claimed £129.50 with her best pen, Phil Hutchings and family of Chagford made £129 as Roger Alford of Sourton rose to £127 closely followed by David & Jenny Cox of Rackenford at £126. A smart and even run of Suffolk x Mule shorn lamb from the Heard family of Meldon, Okehampton sold readily at £125.50, £125 twice and £124.50 and plenty of other short term lambs trading £120 to £125 with medium lambs usually all £100 to £120 and even some better bred longer term lambs into three figures with lesser bred sorts still very much in the late £80's and £90's. Hill lambs maybe the only sticky part of the sale with the better end ok and similar to recent weeks whilst smaller and plainer sorts were difficult to place but all included in that average of £102.

#### **116 GRAZING EWES & I GOAT**

The 116 grazers were keenly sought after and well bid for with Nigel and Tissa Haley of Buckfastleigh reaching £114 of their best Hampshire Down, followed by Alistair and Thomasina Wilmington at £108 & £106 with K Allard down from Bristol selling a ram at £100.

#### **306 BREEDING EWES & 7 STOCK RAMS**

313 breeding sheep saw a blistering trade for the few Charollais and Texel rams on offer with Charollais shearlings selling to £450, £440 & £370 for Colin and David Smallacombe of Bow and a Texel 6T ram from the Shervington family of Hittisleigh achieved £300. The much admired run of scanned In-lamb Dorset's due end of November from the Elford family down from Dorchester met with plenty of interest and keen bidding to see the FM ewes peak at £225 & £205, 4-6T aged ewes reach £220 & £190 and shearlings with just over 100% lambs make £185. Their leaner in lambers and those missing teeth sold from £150 to £170 and ewe lambs from the home soared to £170. Tony Pickard of South Molton sold 6T-FM Suffolk x Mule ewes well at £182 & £168 and Katherine Bassett of South Brent sold 4T aged Lleyn ewes well at £180, £175, £172 twice and £160. Crossbred shearlings that had lambed in the spring sold to £150 for two different vendors, Philip Glanville of Exbourne dispersed his Suffolk x flock to tops of £145 twice and £138, £135 etc and other more non-descript breeders trading from £60 to £140 in front of a good crowd of bidders, buyers and onlookers.
