### THE INAUGURAL SALE OF DARTMOOR HILL PONIES



On Tuesday 29th October Kivells were delighted to work with the Dartmoor Hill Pony Association Wild to Wonderful and Friends of the Dartmoor Hill Pony conducting a very special sale, that saw the realization of one persons dream that was almost 25 years in the making. Through tremendous hard work, determination and sheer passion from Mrs Dartmoor Pony herself, Charlotte Faulkner, the sale was a huge success and congratulations must go to her, her team and all who have helped her along this long and arduous journey and those that helped on the day.

Nearly 180 ponies from 16 different vendors from across Dartmoor exhibited ponies at a bespoke pop up market at the Grange Equestrian Centre, Okehampton sell to 55 buyers from all over the Westcountry, South Wales, Norfolk, Northamptonshire, Warwickshire and as far North as Dumfrieshire in Scotland. Many of whom took advantage of the sale benefiting, for the first time ever, from the online bidding and streaming platform, Marteye. This proved very popular with 1102 devices streaming the sale live at some point during its 3 hours extent. A total of 27 registered buyers saw 13 successful online purchasers snap up no less than 32 ponies through this ever popular and reliable on line sales platform. But this didn't detract from the sale and local support and ringside bidding was strong and with the sale falling in half term, there were nearly 80 registered buyers and the arena seating area, which seats 500 was well occupied throughout most of the sale provided a great atmosphere within the warm, dry and well lit venue.

Early in the sale, John & Jenny Vanstone of Tavistock topped the sale at £600 for a 2 year old Bay mare as well as selling a Dunn coloured gelding of the same age at £480. Similarly Luke and Hannah Fursdon of Lower Town sold their 2 year olds at £500 twice, £400 & £220 whilst the other side of Spitchwick, the Powell Family of Holne parted with their 2 year olds at £500 & £480 as well as a rising 4 year old at £460. Other older ponies to £260 for Friends of the Dartmoor Hill Pony, £180 for the Abel Family of Tavistock, £120 for Scott McNulty of Yelverton and £110 for the Cole Family also of Yelverton. Amongst the large array of this years foals, the spotty ones proved most popular with Mary Alford of Tavistock seeing a lovely little spotted filly get bid to £800 whilst Phil & Richard Coaker of Postbridge sold their little spotty at £440 and the Cole Family claimed £200 for a Dunn spotted colt. Mary Alford's Vixen herd ticked all boxes for breeding, presentation, appeal and salability with her cute little foals selling to £380, £300, £260, £220 and £200 numerous times to average over £150 of 28 mixed sex little foals. Pete & Charlie Mann of Widecombe sold a young colt well at £220 and plenty of other filly foals traded £100 to £180 whilst their brothers were more like £40 to £80.

### Store Steers to £1900 Store Heifers to £1620

A super yarding of store cattle here at Exeter this week with 350 head penned and sold amongst well over 600 on offer with the suckled calves and stirks. Trade motoring on with strong buyer support again, when all looked dearer on the week, with especially those middling £950 to £1100 steers and heifers very much wanted. Store steers topped at £1900 given for an outstanding home bred red Limousin (21m) from Michael and Joy White of Lewannick whilst the better of the later born Limousin bullocks (15m) came back at £1280 for a lovely bunch of five from William Bromell of Chagford. Charolais steers next in line when rising to £1870 (26m) for Dan Tooze of Broadsands with slightly younger sorts (22m) from James Irish, Broadhempston easing to £1630 and a quality (just 7m) Charolais drawing a massive £1200 for Sandy Harvey in from Broadwoodwidger. Dan Tooze back when parting with a grand South Devon steer (25m) for £1670 closely followed by Steve Cockrem up from Plympton who saw his trio of well bred South Devons (21m) realise £1660 apiece whilst neighbours Steve and Rachel Lang sold their best South Devon bullock (18m) for £1430. Anthony Rew and Family, Newton Abbot sold a strong Salers bred steer (30m) for £1600 whilst classy British Blue bullocks (26m) reached £1590 for lames Irish with others of that age close at £1580 for Dan Tooze, also, aged Aberdeen Angus ran to £1530 for Janet Dee of Brandis Corner. Younger Angus steers (18m) sold on behalf of AJ Middleton and Sons in from Woodbury still reached £1500 with Beef Shorthorn steers (24m) off the same good farm making £1400 a life for a pen of three. Hereford bred bullocks (26m) sold readily again this week and rose to £1480 for Jonathan Strout up from Rilla Mill and to £1420 (25m) for Andrew Banbury of Crediton. Other steer returns of interest included five rangy but smart Simmentals (26m) at £1280 apiece for Rob and Sara Jane Baker of Kingsbridge together with Meuse Rhine Issel bullocks (22m) making £1200 for Mike and Steve Gilpin of Dawlish and the best of the Friesian bred steers (24m) st £1190 for Andrew Peters and Family of Talaton. A couple of smart, solid looking Limousin heifers (18m) topped that section when fetching £1620 a life for Michael and Joy White again with others of that breed (23m) levelling out at £1450 for AJ Middleton and Sons and £1400 for Frank and Martin Saunders from Templeton. A pair of matching British Blue and Friesian females (30m) from James Irish pushed their way up to £1510 each whilst Charolais (22m) sold to £1440 and £1430 for David and Andy Mortimer, Sowton Village and AJ Middleton and Sons respectively together with another young (7m) Charolais from Sandy Harvey when her eye catching heifer drew £1060. Better of the South Devon heifers came from Steve and Rachel Lang with their tidy bunch of five (20m) rising to £1360 apiece whilst Aberdeen Angus (20m) eased to £1180 for Mike and Steve Gilpin and then reached £1150 for four well farmed sorts from Dave Parris and Family of Yarcombe and £1100 for Duncan Parris and Family in from Upottery. Rob and Sara Jane Baker were back when selling a big bunch of nine well kept Hereford heifers (26m) for £1060 each.

A cracking day in the stirk pens with quality runs of suckled calves being well rewarded and meeting a tremendous trade throughout. The 2nd Show and Sale of Suckled Calves produced some fine consignments with the White Family of Lewannick witnessing a top price of £1310 for Charolais cross steers (9m). Rob & Sue Greep of Cornwood continued their wonderful run of Limousin cross suckled calves topping out at £1290 with others to £1250 (11m) (All were sired by the Limousin pedigree bulls Killerton Panorama and Rhonllwyn Noble). Sandra Harvey of Broadwoodwidger presented one of the finest line up of suckled calves seen for some time, genuine Charolais cross steers (6m) hitting £1290 with others (7m) realising £1280, £1270, £1210, £1190 & £1120. Mike & Janet Folland down from Roborough presented further Charolais cross steers (8m) which obtained £1210 whilst the Robinson Family of Plymouth presented tremendous Blue steers (10m) which hit £1190 with Charolais steers off the same good farm to £1180. A cracking run from April Hayden & Ollie Tucker of South Poole saw their Charolais steers (8m) level out at £1100 with Limousin cross steers (9m) off the same good farm to £1090. Other note worthy prices saw Andrew Baker of Marldon present Limousin cross steers (8m) to £990 whilst Steve Palmer of Moretonhampstead saw Charolais cross steers (11m) to £950 with Richard Langdon down from Molland seeing similar Charolais cross steers to £940. Dairy bred Blue steers from Steve Palmer (9m) raced to £890 whilst Josh Webber of Yarcombe presented dairy bred Angus steers (12m) which levelled out at £880, with Blues off the same farm and of a similar ilk to £810. Heifers topped the day at £1100 (x2) for Rob & Sue Greep presenting Limousin crosses (10m) with others to £1090. Charolais cross heifers (7m) from Sandra Harvey attained £1050 with others to £940 & £810, whilst the White Family saw their Charolais cross heifers (9m) hit £1035 and Limousin cross heifers reach £1020. The Robinson Family saw Blue heifers (10m) top out at £980 with Charolais heifers off the same farm to £945 and further Blue heifers (9m) to £810. Andrew Baker obtained £800 for his Limousin cross heifers (11m) whilst Blonde cross heifers from David Pengelly & Family obtained £790 (x2). AW Francis of Okehampton saw their Simmental cross heifers (10m) reach £740. ### 1903 STORE LAMBS

Another big day in the sheep pens with nearly every pen full accounting to 3239 sheep in total. The sale started with 1903 store lambs that met with another very fast trade for the great variation of qualities forward. Bigger framed and meated lambs continue to sell well into the £120's with the best few pens breaking the £130 mark and reaching £137 for the last pen sold, a pen of 3 sizable ram lambs from D Attrill of Meshaw. Malcom & Edward Pring of Broadclyst sold a pen of 12 well at £133 as Jean Darby of Whimple claimed £130 of her best with plenty of other short keep but certainly not fit lambs selling £120 to £125. Medium keepers generally £105 to £120 and the better bred longer term lambs today were up a notch from £88 to £105 whilst the very small half bred and bulk of the hill bred lambs sold between £50 and £80 to give an overall average of £100.27, the first three figure average for many weeks and a result of the rising trade not necessarily the quality.

### **76 GRAZING EWES & RAMS**

Grazers peaked at £142 for Matt Rogers farming of Yealmpton, as Lucy and Will Hawker of Shaugh Prior made £136 & £133 and H Jones of Okehampton achieved £134 of their best.

### 1170 BREEDING EWES/EWE LAMBS & 43 STOCK RAMS

A big end of season entry of breeding sheep met with a more selective trade overall. A pen of nice locally bred Mule shearlings from the Steer family of Ashburton sold to £170 as the Burrough family of Axminster sold Exlana x Eastcare yearlings at £155 (x3) and £140. Other shearlings at £152 for Zwartbles from Robert Partridge of Teignmouth, £135 for Romneys from TL Knight of Sidmouth and white headed shearlings at £134 for the Jones family of Yeovil. Ewe lambs similarly met with a selective trade but benefited from the presence of store lamb buyers. That said Brian Westcott of Exford followed up from his success at the last sale with April born pure Dorset lambs at £162 & £140 as well as two pens of Bluefaced Leicester x Dorset lambs at £141. Denis Jones and family traveled down from Heasley Mill with a great run of Suffolk x Mule ewe lambs that looked too good to feed and kill and were justly rewarded with 4 pens at £146, two pens at £145 and two pens at £139. Other strong Suffolk crosses at £141 & £134 for Derek & Ashley Purchase of Bratton Fleming, £130 for Zwartbles x Texel's from Jethro Kimber of Merton and more Suffolk crosses at £134 for David & Lynda Pellow of Sourton. Rams continue to be in high demand with the Quick family of Zeal Monachorum selling a Texel at £580, Tony England of Tiverton had Charollais at £500, £480 & £460, Russell Stevens of Crediton made £500 & £480 twice of his and both the Dart family of Molland and Steve & Rachel Lang of Plympton sold rams at £400 to give an overall average of £332 for all rams sold.

#### 13 CHAROLLAIS & 34 SUFFOLK PEDIGREE & MV FEMALES

The annual society sales of pedigree and MV accredited females on behalf of the Charollais and Suffolk sheep societies sold before a decent crowd of ringside and Marteye buyers with a strong trade for the right goods. Charollais were up first and just two consignors this year saw Will Whiting of Liskeard sell powerful and stylish shearlings carrying triplets at 600gns twice and 580gns as well as his twin bearing shearlings at 550 and 520gns. Carol Irwin of Kings Nympton dispersed the last of her Brandywells Charollais flock with a high of 1000gns and others at 720, 680 and 620gns twice. Suffolks included a few very special individuals with the four figure barrier broken three times, firstly John Howard of Crediton sold the Overall Champion a twin bearing shearling for 1050gns quickly followed just two lots later by the unshown single carrying shearling from Robin Irwin of Kings Nympton that realised 1000gns. Robin also exhibited the headliner, a show stopping, massive ewe lamb, this pick of this years crop; she sold at 2600gns. Other in-lambers to 700 & 550gns for Aimee Mogford of Nomansland and to finish the sale Graham Reddaway of Winkleigh parted with a tremendous pen of ewe lambs that sold readily at 900, 820, 620 & 520gns.


