Store Steers to £2520 Store Heifers to £2180 Store steers averaged £1664 - Store Heifers averaged £1552

Decent store cattle numbers forward here at Exeter this week especially considering we are still in January. No easing in this new era of higher returns with all cattle selling to a phenomenal trade once more. Strong buyer support, both from away and closer to home seen again, not only for those stronger, shorter term sorts, but also for the many younger, middling type steers and heifers on offer which looked every bit as dear in comparison. Steers ran out to a staggering top of £2520 given for a pen of five outstanding British Blues (20m) from Steven Slade and Family of Aylesbeare with other pens of that age from the same sellers reaching £2340 and their later born ones (18m) still running to £2140. Further eye catching British Blues steers (22m) from David and Wendy Holland, Dolton rang the bell as well when three bunches of fives racked up a hefty £2180, £2060 and £2000 a head whilst Steven Slade and Family returned and parted with four tremendous Charolais steers (20m) for £2200 apiece and a couple of smart Devon bred steers of the same age for £2180 each. These were followed by Dan and Emma Kirk of Ashwater who sold a pair of younger (17m) Charolais for £1880 a life. A pen of five grand matching steers (21m) which consisted an Aberdeen Angus, a Hereford and a couple of South Devon bred sorts from David Harris of Stoke Fleming drew strong interest and quickly reached £2170 apiece whilst straight South Devon bullocks (21m) from Christopher Sutton Scott Tucker also up from Stoke Fleming saw bunches rise to £2170 and £2020. Other steer prices to catch the eye included a solitary Aberdeen Angus (21m) from Steven Slade and Family at £1900 whilst further native breed steers drew £1850 for a pair of strong Hereford bullocks (21m) from Trevor Stevens in from Chittlehampton and David Skelley of Shaugh Prior parted from his bunch of six well-bred and fed Shorthorn steers (21m) for £1470. The latter also sold a tidy bunch of British Blonde bullocks (21m) for £1770 although they were eclipsed by a couple of slightly older Blondes from Jon Vincent of Staddiscombe, Plymouth which eased to £1800 apiece. Matthew Wilson, Dunsford chipped in when selling a very smart yearling Limousin steer for a creditable £1780. Plenty to shout about in the store heifer section too with a top of £2180 given for two high calibre Limousins (21m) from Steven Slade and Family with Charolais (21m) from the same good home close at £1980, these were followed by a grand single South Devon of the same age at £2000 for David Harris who also saw his nicely covered Hereford female (20m) make £1960. As ever, plenty of those well turned out British Blue heifers about again this Friday with one (20m) hitting £1910 for Steven Slade and Family again followed by others, all born around the same time at £1890 for Dan and Emma Kirk and £1800 for Alison Clack of Kenn. John Vincent back and selling a trio of super British Blonde heifers (22m) for £1760 apiece as was Steven Slade and Family when parting with a stout Devon of the same age also for £1760. Further South Devon heifers (27m) looked well sold when coming back at £1700 for Phil and Richard Coaker of Postbridge as did four top notch Salers cross Charolais females (18m) which were just a bid back at £1690 for Michael Vooght of Hennock. Hereford heifers £15m) ran to £1440 for Pete Snell in from Awliscombe followed by Aberdeen Angus (26m) at £1350 for RN Giles and Son of Down Thomas and a trio of Friesian females (21m) sold for Evershot Farms of Weymouth returned £1140 apiece

Willie Jamison & Family sold Charolais cross heifers (8m) levelling out at £900, the same figure achieved for similar goods from G Marquand. A useful pen of Simmental cross heifers from John May of Crediton realised £825 (10m) whilst Herefords of a similar age from EC Mills & Son reached £805. Galloway bulls from Richard Langdon topped out at £700 with young Simmental bulls from John May (7m) hitting £690. Younger cattle desperately needed to meet this current exceptional demand.

Top money to the Cobbledicks up from Bude with a single at £160 as well as its pen mates at £158 as Vivian O'Sullivan of Hittisleigh sold a pen of 9 at £158 and Dave & Michelle Wootton of Ashreigney sold forward hoggs at £158, £157.50 twice and £157 followed by John Kittow of Broadclyst with a penful at £154. Mediums usually always £115 to £135 with longer term sorts either side of £100 if nicely bred and more like £50 to £80 if hill bred to give an overall average of £114.25 back 80p on last week but most classes looking dearer.

93 GRAZING EWES

Just shy of 100 grazers met a faster trade in line with the sharply rising cull ewe trade this week. Messrs Forward of Dorset topped with a Dorset at £194 ahead of Andrew Helmer of Chillington at £178 & £175 with Matt Rogers of Yealmpton at £173 and Anne Brown of Ottery St Mary at £168. Plenty of ewes from £130 to £165 and even with a high percentage of hill ewes the average was £105.

A handful of breeders saw the much admired Texel ewe hoggs from Edward Pring of Broadclyst sell in small pens at £240 & £200 as Vivian O'Sullivan sold her unscanned March lambing ewes well at £202 & £188.

155 families in the couples amounted to nearly 400 lives which were just very similar in price to last week. Doubles to £400 twice and singles to £320 twice and plenty of outfits £120-£140 throughout the sale. Early in the sale Edward Pring sold a Texel FM with twin ram lambs at foot for £400 and this was later equalled by Denis Jones and Family of Heasley Mill with a pen of 6 five crop Suffolk x Mule ewes with young Texel twins with their next pen of the same at £370. Chris and Sue Popham of Trull sold Suffolk x Mules with young Charollais twins at £370 as well as a Dorset Mule twin at £350. West Upham Farm sold a pen of Dorset doubles well at £368, with Margaret Heard of Maundown at £365 and Derek & Martin Cole of Bradninch at £345 & £340 and Sam & Edward Ball and Ben Roberts of Exmouth at £342 & £332. Singles to £320 twice for Mark Thomas and Family of South Petherwin who sold another pair of young Dorset's at £315 whilst Edward Pring had a young Texel single at £310. Denis Jones singles with the same comments as his doubles made £288 with Sam & Edward Ball and Ben Roberts reached £262, Brian Westcott of Exford made £262 & £242 of large pens of singles and Chris & Sue Popham realised £258. Overall averages of £276 per outfit and £107.90 per life.
