

Grazing Cows to £1520

Fewer cattle about this week as we approach those quieter summers months and although the quality on offer were mainly of no great strength or quality, those on offer sold readily and to a flying trade with buyers here at Exeter for all types and ages. Young Limousin steer headed that section for a change when an eye catching single (15m) from William Bromell in from Chagford returned him £1555 whilst a bunch of six super yearling Limousin bullocks looked a dear as anything sold when drawing £1360 apiece for Malcomb and Kim Coumbe of Liskeard. Aberdeen Angus steers next in line with handy bunches (24m) from Russell Retter and Family of Cotleigh seeing them rise to £1500 and £1490 with younger (20m) pens of Angus bullocks realising to £1290 for Robert and Christine Harris of Bickleigh, Tiverton, also, others of that age were just a bid back at £1280 for David and Mary Stark of Denbury. Peter Hooper, Bovey Tracey brought cracking run of stores and saw his British Blue steers (20m) reach £1400 and a pair of Herefords (18m) come back at £1330 although these were eclipsed by an aged Hereford (34m) from RJ Nowell of Chagford at £1370. Russell Williams up from Blackawton saw his well grown Simmental steer (24m) fetch £1360 and Beef Shorthorn steers (21m) reached £1340 for Peter Vooght of South Brent. Devon bred steers (20m) saw a trio from Charlie Horton of Stokeinteignhead sell for £1070 apiece and well-bred and farmed Stabilisers (13m) saw £980 for Nigel Gribble of Launceston. As with the steers, Limousin heifers (20m) from William Bromell topped that section when drawing £1435 apiece for a pen of four followed again with tremendous yearling Limousins from Malcolm and Kim Coumbe this time with their heifers rising to an impressive £1265. Peter Hooper back when selling his best British Blue heifer (21m) for £1320 with British Blonde females (22m) close at £1300 for David Skelley of Shaugh Prior. £1270 was seen twice, firstly for EA Maile and Son of Sampford Courtenay with three decent Charolais (19m) with the same amount drawn by Rob Summers of Harcombe, Sidmouth with an Aberdeen Angus (30m). Robert Summers also saw a pair of Hereford heifers (24m) yield £1070 each whilst more Devons from Charlie Horton saw his heifers (22m) return £940 and further Stabiliser stores from Nigel Gribble saw his bunch of five heifers (13m) fetch £915 a life. A respectable entry of grazing cows forward this Friday with the very best selling to £1520 for a South Devon from Terry and Jennifer Arscott of Chagford whilst Chris and Barbera Palk of South Brent saw better of their South Devon grazers reach £1360

75 STIRKS & SUCKLED CALVES

A quieter day in terms of numbers and purchasers around the ring, yet trade remaining firm. Paul Brimacombe & Family down from Yeoford presented further neat dairy bred stirks with Angus' (8m) topping out at £860 with Blues just behind reaching £850 and further Angus' steers levelling out at £780 (8m). GJ Horn in from Okehampton presented Limousin cross steers (9m) which hit £720 whilst Friesian Steers from Paul Brimacombe & Family (9m) realised £540. Heifers topped out at £800 for Paul Brimacombe & Family (9m) with younger types (7m) to £660 and Angus heifers off the same good farm (8m) to £610. Limousin cross heifers from GJ Horn topped out at £660, the same figure achieved for the Pengelly Family of Blackawton presenting Blue heifers (9m) with similar dairy bred types realising £620 (8m) with younger Blue heifers to £450.

A slightly smaller entry of calves forward on Friday, however the calves presented sold to a fantastic trade with plenty of buyers going home empty handed. The Horton Family travelled up from Roborough, Plymouth with a

super box load of Limousin x calves with the best of their month old bulls rising to £422 with more to £345 & £290. Blue bulls reached £410 for a tremendous type in from DW Rowe & Son of Axminster, more blue bulls to £265 from AJ & DM peters of Talaton. Eight week old Angus x reached £268 in from BA Pyne & Son of Budleigh Salterton. Best of the Hereford bulls made £250 (x2) for James Dyer of Milton Abbot. Heifers reached £300 twice firstly for a British Blue heifer in from James Dyer and secondly for a pretty Limousin heifer from the Horton Family. Other British Blue heifers reached £245 for AJ & DM Peters and £225

for CDG & EM Gooding & Son of Ottery St Mary. Young Angus heifers sold well for £185 for BA Pyne & Son who also sold Hereford heifers to £142. Friesian bulls saw plenty of competition selling to £78 for the Hammett Family of Kings Nympton.

220 DAIRY Auctioneer: Mark Davis 07773 371774

Another massive entry of 220 dairy cattle with vendors from far and wide saw an excellent trade throughout with buyers from as far as Shropshire & Wales. The sale commenced with a cracking consignment of 21 grazing type British Friesian & Crossbred cows from Messrs AR Hooper & Partners of Spreyton which sold to a flying trade topping at £2120 for a third calver with others to £2100, £2000 & £1900 twice. The consignment including 5 sixth & seventh calvers averaged £1627! Topping the heifers was Phillip Clarke of Aylesbeare who sold a cracking heifer at £2250. Steve Loud of Colyton sold two British Friesian heifers to £1600 whilst Dave Hunt & Family of South Brent sold two organic heifers to £1650.

The Dispersal of the Robot milked mainly Brown Swiss herd on behalf of Ollie & Zoe Rose of Dulverton sold well to a top of 2,500gns for the much admired fifth calver "Liscombe Alibaba Pia EX93", she sold to Mickey Bennett of Somerset to join his excellent Brown Swiss herd. A Norwegian red x third calver sold at 2,000gns and a good looking Gloucester cow sold very well at 1,900gns. The best of the Friesians in the dispersal sold to 1,850gns for a third calver and other Brown Swiss third calvers sold at 1,750gns & 1,700gns whilst the best of the Swiss heifers topped at 1,600gns. Dry cows topped at 1350gns for a British Friesian fifth calver due in July. The overall average including all faulted cows was £1350.

A consignment of 80 out of block Crossbred cows & heifers from Kingston Hill Farm Ltd of Oxford sold to an excellent trade particularly for the October & November calvers which topped at £1800 three times for Swedish Red & Brown Swiss x cows with others to £1750 twice and many of the best cows between £1500-£1700. The cows which had calved last autumn and not back in calf were harder to place but overall the group sold very well.

A large entry of in calf heifers sold very well with a consignment of 26 British Friesian heifers due in the Autumn from S Talor Farming Ltd of Okehampton selling well to a top of £1500 with others to £1420 twice & £1400 three times. Norwegian Red x Jersey in calf heifers due in October topped at £880 for Alex Green of Somerset who also sold a consignment of pedigree Jersey bulling heifers which looked good value at £310.

5 ORPHAN LAMBS

Just 5 orphan lambs as the season draws to a close, all of which were weaned sorts and sold between £45 and £70 to average £52 with top money coming from Kevin Hilborn of Horndon and Handsford Farm of North Tawton sold a pair at £50.

100 STORE LAMBS/HOGGS

Exactly 100 store lambs and hoggs met with competitive bidding once again with lambs topping at £156 for Neil Hardy of Morchard Road as K Owens of Lympstone made £155, H & M Farmers of Newton Abbot reached £147 and Matt Williams of Ottery St Mary reached £140 with Dorset lambs. Best of the hoggs to £128 for the Gopal family of Diptford as Vicky Richards of Yealmpton sold a large pen at £119 and Haviland Bunt of Liskeard made £114.

54 GRAZING EWES

Grazers reached £161 for a large Berrichon Ram from Mervyn Brice of Stoodleigh, with other rams at £130 & £128 for R Williams of Hemerdon who also had ewes at £123 & £107 and Katie Rice of Cadeleigh sold ewes at £128.

171 EWES/HOGGS & 237 LAMBS (408 LIVES)

171 ewes and hoggs with 237 lambs at foot forward to a larger crowd of buyers and a very buoyant trade, in contrast to last week when it looked like the season was drawing to a close. Trade today very lively and more could have been sold. The first lot sold was an eye-catching pen of 3 Charollais ewes with 5 strong purebred lambs from Robert Partridge of Teignmouth that rose to £420 or £157.50 per life. Another lot in the 400's being a tremendous black Texel FM double at £405 (£135/life) from Messrs Adcock and Wotton of Moretonhamstead who also had other strong doubles at £380 and £370 twice as well as singles at £305 (£152.50/life). TP & KJ Welch of Awliscombe sold smart Texel type ewes with twins at £370 & £350 as well as singles at £262 and similarly Handsford Farm Partners sold Texel x doubles at £355, Mules to £352, £342 & £318 as well as smart singles at £245 to a keen young shepherd. Other Mule doubles at £332 for Tony Pickard of South Molton and younger Dorset doubles from Neil Hardy peaked at £285. Hogg singles to £275 for the Fone Family of Upottery as Michael and David Snell of Knowstone sold their tidy Texel x Mule hoggs to £270, £258 & £252 as Mule Hogg singles sold to £270 for Tony England of Tiverton. Overall averages of £106.38 per life and £253 per outfit could be the dearest we've seen since Christmas.

The early season sale of breeding rams saw a small line up sell in front of a small crowd with Roy Endacott of Spreyton selling Charollais at 450gns and 420gns, Jamie Acton of Cheriton Fitzpaine sold a trio of Texel's at 280gns and the Hammett family of Colyford sold a Dorset at 180gns.


