A wonderful entry of quality cattle for our Show & Sale which saw one of the largest crowds around the ring seen for a long time, realising an overall average of $\pounds 1050$ for both older and younger store cattle.

A good run of Simmental steers from Messrs Cornborough Farms, Abbotsham to £1600, with plenty of others £1500+.

Several good framed single suckled heifers sold very well topping at £1740 for two fleshed pure Charolais from Mr GW Bowden, Black Torrington, who sold 19mth Charolais heifers at £1620 and £1540. Limousin heifers from Messrs RH & GA Morrish Ltd £1700 (2). Pure Limousin heifers from Mr PW Endacott, Halwill £1590. Five well farmed Limousin heifers from Messrs A Walter & Son, Putshole, Hartland £1490. British Blues from Messrs RH & GA Morrish Ltd £1560. Pure Stabilisers from Messrs K & L Hutchings, Thornbury saw steers to £1600 (5) and heifers to £1510. Other Native single suckled South Devons from Mr J Collings, Treburley saw steers to £1720 and heifers to £1415. Single suckled Herefords from Mr CJ Wooldridge, Broadbury selling well at £1380 and £1180.

Stronger Dairy X cattle saw another strong trade. British Blue X to £1560 for two from Messrs J & ML Chamberlain, Shebbear. A good run of grazing Limousins from Mr EJ Pincombe, Winkleigh saw steers to £1190. Aberdeen Angus X steers from Messrs J & ML Chamberlain, Shebbear £1500 (3) and £1500 also for two Aberdeen Angus steers from Messrs A Walter & Son, Hartland. Young 9mth single suckled Limousins from Mr SG Thorne, St Giles on the Heath £186, Aberdeen Angus to £880 and young Limousin heifers from the same farm £835. Cracking young single suckled Devons 12mths from Mr JA Slee, Buckland Brewer raced away to £1280 (3).

A "VAN" is valid for 12 months.

AUCTIONEERS UPLOAD VENDORS "VAN" INTO THE MARKET SYSTEM

Any livestock that are not accompanied by a "VAN" or assurance scheme membership will be announced at point of sale.

FOLLOWING SALE, THE "VAN"/ASSURANCE NUMBER FOR EACH LOT WILL BE PROVIDED TO THE PURCHASER ON THEIR SALES INVOICE

This can be provided to the abattoir Vet if/when required.

VET ATTESTATIONS HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE CHANGES

Prior to <u>13th December 2023</u>, livestock producers should arrange a veterinary visit on farm for completion of the Veterinary Attestation Declaration.

This visit can coincide with any other routine on-farm veterinary visit, or Animal Health & Welfare Pathway Review. Speak to your Auctioneer for more details (AHWP - England Only).

In some cases, vets may be able to provide retrospective Veterinary Attestation Declaration if a recent on-farm visit has taken place that meets the requirements.

OR producers can provide evidence of a qualifying assurance scheme. (Red Tractor, FAWL WLBP, OMS)

(Red Tractor, FAWL WLBP, QMS)

The requirement for Veterinory Attestations for all livestock sold for slaughter is due to a change in EU legislation. Guidance provided by the Livestock Auctioneers Association Limited www.laa.co.uk

VET ATTESTATIONS WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW?

IS A "VAN" NUMBER REQUIRED FOR ALL LIVESTOCK?

No. A "VAN" is only required for livestock sold for slaughter, from the consigning holding.

IS THERE A MINIMUM RESIDENCY PERIOD FOR THE LAST HOLDING? The requirement for a "VAN" number is applicable only to the last holding, regardless of residency period.

WHAT HAPPENS IF A VENDOR DOES NOT HAVE A "VAN" OR MEMBERSHIP OF AN ASSURANCE SCHEME BY 13TH DECEMBER 2023?

Any livestock without a "VAN" or membership of a qualifying assurance scheme will be identified at point of sale and may not be eligible for export.
