



Prime Cattle to 292ppk & £1824 Barren Cows and Cull Bulls to 174ppk & £2017

Lower number forward this week, although those which were on offer met another strong trade when prime cattle topped at a creditable 292ppk given for an outstanding Limousin heifer from Adrian and Bradley Bowden, Drewsteignton, which at 626kg returned £1824. Further good Limousin heifers off the same farm ran to £1693 (606kg × 280ppk) and £1630 (592kg × 276ppk) followed by a couple of well covered Hereford steers from Joe Stoneman and Family of Sampford Courtenay that came back at £1543 (588kg × 263ppk) and £1541 (628kg × 246ppk). Just one cull bull on offer this week when a massive 1234kg Simmental from Tony Francis in from Okehampton sold readily and for 164ppk and £2017. No real stars in the cull cow pens although a meaty Devon barrener from Adrian Pike in from Nymet Rowland did reach £1325 (764kg × 174ppk) and the better of a pair of Charolais drew £1284 (758kg × 170ppk) for Michael and Carolyn Northmore of Cornwood. Alan Luscombe, Bickington saw Aberdeen Angus cows reach £1127 (730kg × 155ppk) and a neat South Devon realise £1069 (720kg × 149ppk).

1940 PRIME SPRING LAMBS

More lambs forward at 1940 head and noticeably more grass finished and under finished lambs on offer today amongst that larger yarding. SQQ was 6p less at 303ppk but due mainly to quality with the good weekly consignments every bit as dear as last week if not dearer. The £200 mark was breached again today with Ollie Eavis of Exminster selling a 70kg lamb at £203 closley followed by Andrew Hendy of Diptford at £199, Derek Arnold of Morchard Road with his first draw at £193 and Phillip & Richard Harris of Stockleigh Pomeroy selling two lots at £180. Andrew Hendy back in again with a single 53kg lamb at ± 174 or a section topping 328ppk whilst messrs Milborne Wick Farms of Sherborne sold their best at £171. Best of the 51's today at £164.50 for both Trevor Selway of Sidmouth and Lin Loosemore of Yeoford as Mick May of Copplestone made £164 of his and smart pen of 49kgs from the Bowditch Family of Hawkchurch realised £163.50 as super 46kg lambs from Rich Berry of Kenn soared to £160 or a market topping 340ppk. 45kgs to £142.50 for Jerry Sanders Carr of Exminster narrowly in front of the Bowditch Family again at £141.50 and no less than 4 pens from different vendors at £140 or more. 44's to £139 for both FC Archer of Pennymoor and Steve Ley and Hannah Payne of Liskeard as 43's

reached £136 for Alex Lawler of Nomansland and a smart pen of 40kg Blue Texel's from M Brown of Newquay rose to £131. Lighter lambs similar on the week too with 39's at £121 for Michael Ayre of Thorverton as 38's made £120 for the Persey Family of Broadhembury and 37's achieved £117.50 for A Moss of Morchard Bishop.

Still a few old season prime about with Hoggs selling to £128 for Tony Butt of Tiverton as toothers reached £160, £146, £138.50 & £135 for Martin & Adam Crabb of Luppitt and £150 for Steve Ley & Hannah Payne.

1360 CULL EWES & 21 RAMS

Nearly 1400 cull sheep were a similar trade overall amidst reports of lower prices later last week and everything selling well at recent high levels. Best ewes few and far between today with Jonny Baker of Taunton reaching \pounds 245 with his best and others at \pounds 195 & \pounds 188. David Curtis and family sent sheep down from Aylesbury to see their best shapely Beltex's to \pounds 225 and larger pens at \pounds 198 & \pounds 186 as Steve Ley and Hannah Payne sold a Roussin at \pounds 200, Vivian O'Sullivan of Hittisleigh claimed \pounds 198 of her best and J Hamby of Okehampton sold two lots at \pounds 195. Plenty of crossbred ewes trading from \pounds 150 to \pounds 185 with a run of 90 tremendous mainly Berrichon types ewes from the Wrixon family of Wimborne topping at \pounds 190 averaging \pounds 168. Mules mainly in the \pounds 130's for the better end with an odd single either side of \pounds 140 and leaner sorts often \pounds 110 to \pounds 125. Hill ewes not as far back as we'd feared with not just as many about this week, Greg Hutchings of Launceston sold his weekly consignment of Welsh ewes to \pounds 86 and \pounds 80 and they're not getting any bigger as the weeks go on. Other Scotch, Swale and Jacobs selling well into the \pounds 80's also and an average of \pounds 121 was achieved across all ewes. Tups to \pounds 185 for a pair from Ann Bond of Axminster and \pounds 152 for Simon Booty of Poundsgate as the Knights of Fluxton sold at pair at \pounds 148.
