Important Regulations:

1. Membership Requirement:

In order to benefit from our microchip and passport service (details below) you must be a fully
paid-up member of the Dartmoor Hill Pony Association. If you are unsure of your membership
status, please contact us at association@dartmoorhillpony.com

2. Microchipping Requirement:

• Thanks to the *Friends of the Dartmoor Hill Pony* we are able to offer a **microchip and passporting service** on the day for ponies sold at the sale. Your ponies will be microchipped before leaving the market at a cost of £35 each, payable by the buyer. This fee also includes the cost of a passport.

3. Passport Application:

 Please complete Page 1 of a passport application form, available from Charlotte Faulkner at passports@dartmoorhillpony.com. The cost is £1.50 per form. Each form has a unique number and must not be photocopied. It is the vendor's responsibility to ensure the passport application is correctly filled out and includes all relevant sections.

4. Vendor Responsibility:

• The vendor is solely responsible for ensuring that each pony's passport application information matches the pony. Ponies that cannot be readily identified by their paperwork will not be penned for sale.

5. Microchipping at Sale:

• No pony sold will be allowed to leave the sale yard without a microchip inserted by the DHPA vet and the correct paperwork completed, unless returning to the farm of origin for registration with the Dartmoor Commoners Council.

6. Health Requirements:

Any pony that appears unfit for sale or shows symptoms of any contagious equine disease will
not be accepted. Please consult your vet if you have any doubts about your pony's health, as it is
an offense to present an unfit horse for sale. For further details, please refer to The Welfare of
Horses at Markets Act.

7. Commission:

A 10% commission, including VAT, will be applied to all sales.

8. Online Sales:

• If your pony is sold to an online bidder, you will be expected to take the pony home, and the new owner will collect it from you within 5 working days. If you do not wish for your pony to be part of the online sale, please indicate this on the entry form.
