Prime Cattle and Cull Cows

Everything looking well sold in the cattle pens this week with prime and cull stock every bit as dear as we have seen them. Best finished cattle ran to a considerable top of 385ppk for an eye catching, meaty red Limousin heifer from Adrian and Bradley Bowden of Drewsteignton which at 576kg came back at a substantial £2214. Further nicely covered prime heifers reached £2478 (680kg x 365ppk) for Adrian and Bradley Bowden again with a Charolais, followed by a South Devon female from John and Andrew Ball up from Stoke Gabriel which realised £2157 (686kg x 315ppk). Also, a smart Simmental heifer from Andrew and George Palk grossed £1834 (528kg x 348ppk). Some decent returns in the prime steer section too with a Limousin topping out at £2266 (610kg x 372ppk) for Adrian and Bradley Bowden together with Devon bullocks drawing £2109 (644kg x 328ppk) for Bushwhackers of Manaton and £1997 (610kg x 328ppk) for Adrian and Alex Pike of Nymet Rowland. Hereford steers reached £1827 (558kg x 328ppk) for the Clarence Herd of Shillingford, Tiverton and in the over thirty month prime pens we saw a top of £1981 (624kg x 318ppk) given for a Devon steer (36m) from Jon Carden of Payhembury. Cull cows keenly sought after again this week again with a striking Hereford from Ben Wood and Family of Moreleigh topping at a whopping £2394 (930kg x 258ppk). Other cows prices of note included South Devon barreners at £1731 (694kg x 250ppk) for John and Andrew Ball and Simmentals to £1551 (648kg x 240ppk) and £1493 (580kg x 258ppk) both for Andrew and George Palk.

183 PRIME SPRING LAMBS

More springers forward this week and with them more demand aided by a national export buyer, looking for those handyweight lambs to ship across the channel. With this demand for 17-20kg carcasses all handyweighted

lambs from 35 to 42kgs seeing great demand and often achieving more than their heavier counterparts. I urge producers to market lambs when they're either side of 40kgs to make the most of them. A single overweight lamb topped the sale at £183 for Tom Yandle of Oxton but plenty of other 50-55kg lambs trading at hogg levels and realising around the £160 mark. 47kgs to £164 for lan Pincombe of Kennerleigh and £159 for Robert & Edward Mortimer of Kennford who also sold 48's at the same money. Slightly lighter 44kg lambs sold to £168 for Dave Chapple of Cadeleigh whilst 43's sold to £173.50 & £167 for Tom Yandle. Puddington's Alan Bickley always sells early handyweight pure Dorset lambs and today saw his pen of 40's sell at £163.50 (409ppk) whilst his 41's realised £176 or a sale topping 429ppk with Uprising Properties of Ashill Newton Abbot also selling 40kg pure Dorset's at £164.50. A couple of pens of lighter weight saw Merv Woodward of Cullompton sell 38's at £157 whilst the Willaims Family of Southleigh sold little plummy 37kg lambs at £150 and this week seeing difference in trade for coming out of the BTV RZ. Overall the SQQ seeing a massive jump at 384ppk with an all in average of 360ppk and £160.55 per head.

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Just over 2000 hoggs and as seen nationally a plethora of heavies forward which is really starting to a have a negative affect on the trade for these with weight. That said handyweight hoggs were maybe a touch sharper on

the week and in general a lot of hoggs from 44-64kg selling from £150 to £162. That said a smart run of overweights near the end of the sale saw tops of £190 twice and £187 twice for well bred and finished Beltex and Charollais sorts from Martin & Adam Crabb of Luppitt whilst Denis Jones and Family of Heasley Mill are still finding them and reached £180 with heavy Suffolk crosses, £180 also for Russell Stevens of Crediton, Martin & Adam Crabb back in again at £177 and Derek Arnold of Morchard Road sold a single 54kg hogg at £176. A tremendous single 50kg Black Beltex again from Martin & Adam Crabb rose to £180 or 360ppk with other 50-52kgs at £164.40 for Steve Pitts of Germansweek, £164 for Denis Jones and Family and £163 for Robin and Liam Dare of Upottery and a smart single 49kg hogg from JA Vann of Lyme Regis rose to £161. Some great pens of 46kg hoggs saw Rich Northey of Liskeard exhibit another great run of hoggs that saw his best of this weight at £160 and another three pens at £159, with Raymond Jones and Family of Heasley Mill also selling two pens of that weight at £159 and also the Wollacott Family of Bishops Nympton. Rich Northey also had 45's at £158 with the best of the 44's at £155 for Phil Morish of Tedburn St Mary and £153.50 for Martin & Russ Gillbard of Morchard Bishop who also dominated the 40kg weights with their best tow pens at £148 & £147 or

370 & 368ppk. Other 40's at £144.50 for the Strong Family of Crockernwell and £143 again for Phil Morish as 41's peaked at £144 for Merv Uglow of Holsworthy who also had top price 39's at £141. Other lighter weights seeing more 39's at £139 for the Withers Family of Cove as 37's sold to £135 for J Sharples of Longdown and a sweet pen of 34kg keepers from Messrs Chadwick of Higher Ashton sailed to £129 or a sale topping 379ppk.

783 CULL EWES & 50 RAMS

783 cull ewes averaged £146 and the 50 rams levelled at £140, both seeing a marked improvement in trade on the week and the previous few weeks. Not so many best ewes here today but a lively trade however with the best at £315 for a single Texel from Phil Bond and Family of Blackawton who also sold a pair at £268 and another pen of five at £268. Linda Wyatt of Ashill Cullompton sold a Texel type ewe well at £250 and Messrs Johns of Exmoor sold Texel type ewe well at £248, £240 and £212 and Eric & Alex Dennis of North Tawton sold a CharTex ewe at £238. Suffolk cross ewes up a gear also with the best today coming up from Newquay on behalf of Newlyn Farm partnership at £237 as Stephen & Susan Sallis had others at £224, P & M Stoyle of East Village made £217 and both Messrs Ward of Truro and Raymond Jones and Family made £210 of their Suffolk crosses. Lots of business done from £180 to £205 on those Suffolk cross and Texel cross Mules as well as heavy Dorset types. Mules today regularly into the £170's with a top of £176 for both Seward Folland of Puddington and Ian & Catherine Smerdon of Denbury and good meat Mules generally £145 to £165 with lesser sorts normally all north of £100. Hill ewes out in force and good to sell with Jacobs to £168 for Josh Quant of Newton Abbot, Whiteface Dartmoors to £120 for Bowden Partners of Drewsteignton and Abel Bros of Tavistock sold various hill dwelling breeds to £118, £117 & £114. Tups saw a big jump too with some looking £30-£40 dearer on previous weeks, £240 was the top claimed by Paul Vanstone of Bratton Clovelly with Jacob Griffiths of Whitstone selling at £230, Linda Wyatt made £225 & £210, the Woollacott Family of Kings Nympton made £220 and Dave Pollard of Black Dog attained £212.




