### Store Steers to £2720 Store Heifers to £2400 Incorporating our 2025 St Valentines Show and Sale of store cattle

Several more store cattle forward this week with 400 penned and sold, mostly drawn no doubt by this unbelievable trade we are witnessing and our 2025 St Valentines Fair which included some outstanding cattle of all ages with all on offer desperately sought after by the many buyers from away and closer to home out to secure bulk numbers of cattle. Plenty of poorer bred, open shedded younger stores about too, with those again looking particularly dear in comparison to others once again. A staggering eighty three steers sold in excess of £2000 with an amazing top and new market record of £2720 given for grand, standout home bred South Devon bullock (22m) from Michael Tooze of Broadsands who followed up with four more at a mere £2610 apiece. Further South Devon bred steers of note included a cracker (20m) at £2390 for Dan Tooze and an eye catching pen of five (22m) from Christopher Sutton Scott Tucker of Dartmouth which drew £2260 apiece. Plenty of forward, short term Limousin bred steers of high order about again this week with a trio (30m) from Derek Pyle in from Clyst Honiton drawing £2580 a head whilst Brian Vallance and Family of Bickington parted with fine bunches (22m) for £2510 and £2480. Also, three well kept Limousin bullocks (21m) saw £2350 for Dave Lee of Farway and others rose to £2280 and £2250 for Jeff Harvey of Hennock and Mark Wooldridge, Okehampton respectively. More strong steers (27m) saw British Blues ease to £2480 for Andrew Poole of Morchard Road followed by Charolais (24m) returning £2430 for a couple from Brian Vallance and Family and a pair of rangy British Blondes (30m) at £2400 for Derek Pyle. Christopher Sutton Scott Tucker was back when selling a super pen of five Aberdeen Angus steers (22m) for £2380 apiece as was Brian Vallance and Family who saw theirs of a similar age and ilk come back at £1340 together with Dan Tooze with first class Simmental bullocks £23m) at £2270. The customary high calibre offering from Michael Vooght in from Hennock didn't disappoint when his pair of delightful Salers cross steers (18m) easily ran to £2240 whilst a host of tremendous Hereford bullocks were keenly sought after and ran out to £2100 (23m) for Ryan Brice of Chudleigh and £1920 (20m) for the best of a big consignment from Ross Gill up from Looe. Store heifers very much on the wanted list again this week and sparked strong demand when topping at £2400 for a glorious Limousin (30m) from Mark Wooldridge whilst smart, well-bred later born sorts (17m) from Roger Morrish of Torrington picked up £1760. Roger also parted with a couple of trim Charolais females (21m) for £1980 apiece followed by Dave Harris up from Stoke Fleming selling his good Charolais (19m) for £1840. John Hallett of Ottery st Mary would have been happy when seeing his pair of decent Aberdeen Angus heifers (24m) rise to £1920 a life as would Terry Gillbard of Puddington who saw a Blonde (30m) draw £1780, a price matched by Ryan Brice with his British Blue female (24m). Three neat Hereford heifers (20m) from Ross Gill earned him £1640 apiece followed by a solid looking Simmental (21m) at £1540 for Dave Harris and a pen of good Murray Greys (25m) making £1380 each for Charlie and Phillip Gibbins in from Feniton. Just the one cow and calf on offer this week with a super Beef Shorthorn outfit from Collihole Farm, Chagford reaching £2060 whilst grazing cows topped out at £1380 for a grand Devon sold on behalf of Mr and Mrs Eveleigh down from Lynton.

#### **47 ORPHAN LAMBS**

47 orphans kicked things off and were very warmly received to a faster trade for all sorts on offer, especially the smaller and younger lambs with very few less than £20 and a pleasing overall average of £31.34 was achieved. Top money of £54 went to a pair of Charollais crosses from Chris & Katie Stevens of Bickington with next best then a young Suffolk cross lamb at £48 for Gary & Helen Woodman of Chawleigh as V Axon of Yeoford made £42 of a very young lamb and no less than 8 lambs from three separate vendors sold at £40.

### **2068 STORE HOGGS**

A good number of 2068 store hoggs gathered up and overall a very similar trade with the forward sorts every bit as dear, farming/keeping hoggs maybe a pound or two less and the bottom end also a pound or two less but still looking well sold for the very mixed quality forward. Very few killing hoggs in amongst the entry today and hence our average was back £5 at £107, when at worst any hogg was no more than £2 less on the week. The Browse family of Butterleigh topped the market at £153 with a single hogg as Temuka Ltd of South Molton sold a pair at £150, a price matched by the Palk family of Blagdon and both Adrian Nuthall of East Village and Denis Tapp of Rackenford reached £146 of their full pens and so did lan Balsdon and family of Hatherleigh with a big rangey single. Plenty of others in the early £140's and late £130's with medium keep hoggs normally £105 to £120 and longer term hoggs anywhere from £85 to £102 and hill breeds and those sold with faults back at £30 to £80 and all included in that average.

#### 110 GRAZING EWES

Grazers met with good demand once more with a top of £158 going to SJ Bettison of Bolventor as the Browse family claimed £156 of a penful and £141 of a smaller sort with James Palk of Ipplepen reaching £140 and Richard & Angela Smaridge of East Allington selling lambing disaster Suffolk crosses at £138.

#### **64 BREEDING SHEEP**

A few genuine runs of inlamb sheep after last week's big sale saw Tony Pickard of South Molton part with FM Welsh Mules scanned for mid March at £200 as well as NC Mule FM's at £198 & £175 and Suffolk crosses not quite carrying as many lambs at £160. Elsewhere Ray Tucker of Bridford reached £140 and Richard Beckley of Black Dog made £138.

### 125 EWES & 161 LAMBS (286 LIVES)

A few more couples forward this week after last week's lull amongst the breeding sheep bonanza and although there wasn't an abundance of buyers, trade was hot throughout. A stand out run of heavyweight FM Dorset ewes with their young 3-4 week old CharTex sired lambs from Gary & Helen Woodman of Chawleigh sparked spirited bidding which saw them sell two pens of Doubles at £380, another at £368 and further two pens at £358 whilst their singles rose to £290 and £280 as well as others either side of £250. Doubles in short supply with next best then back at £290 for JDR Farms of Scorriton and leaner and plainer sorts from £50 to £80 per life and perhaps looking chancey. Plenty of strength in the singles though with Clyde Coaker of Widecombe selling Suffolks with purebred lambs at £300 and Mike Northcott of Tedburn St Mary reducing his early lambers with Dorset's and nearly reared singles at £290, £272 & £265. A smart pair of 6T Texel cross ewes with young single lambs at foot rose to £270 for Chris and Sue Popham of Trull and Richard & Angela Smaridge sold a pen of 11 Suffolk cross milk one sider singles well at £252. Overall averages of £249 per outfit and £108.70 per life is very similar on the week.
