Trade motoring on in the prime cattle and cull cow pens here again at Exeter on Monday with clean, under thirty month (UTM) heifers seeing a top per kilo of 388 pence given for a quality, trim 546kg Limousin from Adrian and Bradley Bowden of Drewsteignton which also saw £2115. She was followed by a young (20m) British Blonde female of high order from Keith and Hilary Harvey, Bovey Tracey at £2345 (634kg x 370ppk) whilst the several UTM heavyweight steers about this week saw a top price realised of £2415 (756kg x 320ppk) for a nicely covered Hereford bullock from Keith and Hilary Harvey again who also parted with a strong 740kg over thirty month British Blue steer for 328ppk and £2423. Younger (28m) well turned out British Blue steers from Graham Tancock in from Broadclyst came back at £2333 (704kg x 332ppk) and £2324 (712kg x 327ppk) whilst a hefty Hereford bullock from Graham returned £2264 (700kg x 324ppk). Devon steers reached £1782 (576kg x 310ppk) for Adrian Pike of Nymet Rowland with a cull cow of the same breed from Adrian topping that section at a decent £1587 (680kg x 234ppk). Several of the other cull cows on offer would be regarded as grazing type South Devons with one from John Reddaway and Sons in from Cossick Cross realising to £1416 (710kg x 200ppk) whilst the best South Devon from Jon Vincent of Staddiscombe, Plymouth grossed £1284 (580kg x 222ppk). John Gilbert sent a Dexter cow up from Blackawton when she sold readily at £371 (352kg x 106ppk).

Spring lambs remain hard to find and with that shortage comes a lack of consistency and no real desire from any major abattoirs or butchers for springers just yet, hopefully things will improve over the next few weeks.
