Store Steers to £2680 Store Heifers to £2240

This 2025 store cattle trade does still take some getting used to with prices right across the board every bit as dear as we have seen them this week and a head scratching trade again. Not just for those fancy short term steers and heifers which are always easy to place, but men now out in earnest to secure medium and longer term sorts ready for turning out so those proving to be particularly popular. 450 stores penned and sold again this week with top honours in the steer section going to the best of a remarkable run of continental bred bullocks from Dan Gould of Taunton in the way of a pair of outstanding Charolais (22m) which made £2680 apiece. Dan Gould also parted with his next best Charolais (20m) in pair with a Beef Shorthorn for £2440 and a super pen of seven Charolais (18m) for £2380 a life, before also selling a trio of very smart Limousin steers (20m) for £2650 each. Further top quality Limousin bred bullocks saw three of the same age reach rise to £2460 a head for Brian Vallance and Family of Bickington whilst an admirable pen of three Limousins (25m) from C & S Heywood in from Bolham drew £2400 and an eye catching single (23m) from Jason and Cathy Crang of Cadeleigh saw £2370. The same duo also sold solid looking yearling Limousin steers (14m) to a creditable £1720 although these were eclipsed by John Hull of Tiverton who saw his best Limousin youngsters (12m) rise to a premium at £1860 for three. Dan Gould was back when selling well kept British Blonde and Aberdeen Angus steers (22m) to £2420 together with a fine group of five Simmentals (20m) for £2320 apiece whilst solitary Angus steers (20m) reached £2260 and £1960 for C & S Heywood again and Paul Stoneman of Stokeinteignhead respectively. Grand South Devon steers (24m) from John Hamlin of Bickington Came back at £2250 and £2200 with Dan and Emma Kirk up from Ashwater back for a second week and seeing bunches of strong British Blue steers (18m) fetch £2060 whilst their second pick of Herefords (18m) still earned them £1860 for a pen of six. The store heifer section was headed by Christopher Sutton-Scott Tucker of Dartmouth who firstly saw high calibre Aberdeen Angus females (23m) ease to £2240 with five stout Herefords of a similar age and off the same farm for just a couple of bids back at £2020 a life whilst C & S Heywood were back when picking up £2020 a head for four super Limousin heifers (22m), other store heifer prices of interest included a pen of three South Devons (22m) at £1920 for Christopher Stoon-Scott-Tucker together with Beef Shorthorns (20m) running to £1820 for Geoff Arscott and Family of Chagford and Simmentals (24m) making £1820. Also, tremendous bunches of British Blue heifers (18m) from Dan & Emma Kirk came back at £1820 and £1800. Just a few grazing cows about this week with the very best drawing an unbelievable £2500 and £2160 for John & Steph Rogers of Yealmpton with a couple of South Devon barreners.

A jump in numbers saw trade stand on from last weeks flyer! Charolais' lead the way in the heifer section with Trevor & Martine Snell topping out at £1420 (10m) with other pens to £1380, £1340, £1280, £1200 & £1120 (10m). John Redman of Chagford presented similar sorts being Simmental heifers to £1290 whilst further Simmental heifers, this time from MA Stephens realising £1250 (11m). Ollie Stephens up from Liskeard presented Charolais cross heifers (9m) which realised £1130, the same figure achieved for Richard Weeks of Dawlish, this time showing South Devon heifers (9m). GM Thorne & Son attained £1110 for Charolais cross heifers (9m) with their Limousin heifers hitting £1030. Taylors Farm sold Charolais heifers (7m) which raced to £1020 with Limousins off the same good farm levelling out at £1000. Dairy bred Angus heifers from Pl Pengelly attained £950 (12m) with similar goods from JA Darke Limited reaching £890. John & Steph Rogers saw younger dairy bred Angus heifers (8m) realise £870 with others to £740. Goats to £160 & £150 for S Walke of Looe.

1356 BREEDING EWES & EWE HOGGS

Nearly 1400 breeding sheep gathered up for our final in-lamb ewe sale saw a sluggish trade for the empty ewe hoggs with Tony Pickard of South Molton reaching £169 for Suffolk crosses. In lamb Mule ewe hoggs probably weren't the quality of previous years and were a selective trade with Mike Tozer of Totnes seeing the best of his reach £212 (x4), £200 (x2) whilst Devon Farming Ltd of Bratton Fleming made £200 of their best and £195 of six pens. The in-lamb ewes were dominated by a truly tremendous run of 356 entirely homebred mainly Scotch Mules from Robert & Richard Rowe and family of Simonsbath, they sold eight pens at £252, four at £248, four at £240 and six at £232 with nothing less than £225 to average £238. Andrew Hill of Wells also hit £240 with his best two pens of NC Mules and others at £218 twice, Jonny & Cathy Bowles of Slapton sold all three of their pens of Romney ewes well at £222 and plenty of other business doen either side of £200 to leave a breeding sheep average of £193 for all ewes, hoggs and the empty hoggs.
