574 Tractors, Machinery & Effects – Auctioneer: David Kivell & Charlie Kivell

A staggering 574 lots of larger machinery filled the yard this month achieving a 92% overall clearance and 59% of lots receiving online bids!

Top call of the day was for a 2012 Case 921F loading shovel with 10,220 hours on the clock which topped at £21,500. A 2005 Volvo FH460 with 11 months MOT went under the hammer for £13,000. The top of the tractors made £12,500 for a 1996 Massey Ferguson 6170 with a recent new starter and hydraulic pump. A tidy example of a 2010 JCB 190 robot with 6,718 hours topped at £7,100. A Field Marshall series 2 which was in locally as part of a dispersal topped for an impressive £5,900! Following this was a 2018 Siroma RF404A with loader and pallet forks at £5,000.

An impressive 25 trailers on offer this month with the best topping at £12,000 for a Smyth 14T silage trailer. A 2004 Bateson 16ft cattle box went under the hammer for £4,100.

A wide range of machinery and implements on offer this month. The top call in this section was £6,600 for a 2014 Herbst 2750 gallon slurry tanker. A Spreadwise front reeler achieved £6,500.

A great start to the new year with 689 smaller lots entered which were sold to a vast amount of keen purchasers from start to finish, with potentially the largest crowd we have ever seen here in the winter months. From pillar drills to go carts. We can sell it all!

Top of the day for this section was a mud head buggy coming in at £330. Another high price to be noted was for a max weed/brush cutter making £300. A wood burner making £162 as well as set of sheep weigh scales making £152. Dumpy bags of logs sold extremely well this month with bags making £102 and others making £70 and £55 respectively. Best of the tools saw a Bosch saw bench stand making £100 and Record pillar drill making £86.
