A chilly sale this month with a large crowd to round up the year with a top call of £11,100!

389 Tractors, Machinery & Effects – Auctioneer: David Kivell

389 lots of bigger machinery were entered this month with an 89% clearance, with 56% of lots receiving an online bid and 28% of lots selling online via MartEye.

Top call of the day was £11,100 for a Shelbourne Reynolds power spread dairy 1600. Followed by a 1994 John Deere 2850 with a Quicke 2300 loader and 10,900 hours on the clock to £10,500.

The best of the trailers made £4,600 for a 2011 tailor made 16ft shoot trailer, followed by £4,500 for a 20ft Bateson livestock trailer.

A 2017 Polaris Ranger for £4,300, a 2014 Polaris Ranger to £4,050 and a 2014 Ifor Williams DP120 14ft livestock trailer to £4,200.

A Kubota L4200 to £3,450 and a Hi Spec 2500 gal vacuum tanker with a sprung drawbar to £3,400.
