

438 Tractors, Machinery & Effects – Auctioneer: David Kivell

438 lots of bigger machinery were entered this month with a 91% clearance, with 59% of lots receiving an online bid and 31% of lots selling online via MartEye.

Top call of the day was £28,500 for a 2016 Land Rover Defender 90 with 69,000 miles on the clock. The best of the tractors made £17,000 for a 2008 Deutz Agrotron 150 Fahr having done 9,000 hours, closely followed by £16,000 for a 2014 JCB handler with 7,200 hours on the clock.

A smart example of a 2010 Land Rover Defender 90 made £15,000 having done just shy of 80,000 miles.

A 2016 Krone 4 rotor rake with electric controls made £9,500. A 2019 Kubota V10.3 with 4 buckets and 12,000 hours on the clock made £7,900. A very tidy 2016 Ford Fiesta with 68,000 miles on the clock reached £4,900 and a 2015 Polaris Ranger reached £4,150. An Abbey 3000 slurry tanker complete with air brakes made £4,100.

Top price went to an anvil vice selling to £160, a wooden shed to £110 and space heater to £100, all non VAT items. Four 643 tractor batteries selling to £95 each, a Stihl chainsaw to £90.

VAT items to £60 for a Honda water pump another Jonred chainsaw to £60, £40 twice for crate Kubota single cylinder diesel engine. Dumpy bags of firewood selling to £50.

A record breaking entry of 505 lots this month, drawing a huge crowd.


A good variety of dog food this month. Plenty of wet meat x 12 tins of Butchers to £10.


