A quieter sale this month due to storm Ciaran which saw a top call of £12,100!

325 Tractors, Machinery & Effects – Auctioneer: David Kivell

325 lots of bigger machinery were entered this month with an 85% clearance, with 51% of lots receiving an online bid and 29% of lots selling online via MartEye.

Top call of the day was £12,100 for a 2020 John Deere XUV865M gater with 3,076 hours on the clock. Followed by a 2008 8 tonne Takuchi TB180FR having done 8,755 hours to £8,000.

The best of the tractors made £7,200 for a Ford 7840 having done 6,900 hours, followed by £5,700 for an International 785 with loader and bucket.

The best of the vehicles made £5,600 for a 2012 Ford Ranger having done 154,000 miles and a 2010 Toyota Hilux with 97,000 miles on the clock to £5,400.

A McConnel PA52 power arm hedge trimmer to £5,500, a 2002 Komatsu 1.5 tonne mini digger with 3,700 hours on the clock to £4,100 and a 2008 Redrock 2000gal vacuum tanker to £3,400.



Chainsaws sold to £100 for a Dolmar with alloy wheels selling to £80, calf feeders to £70, top link to £70 and toolboxes to also £70.


