Top call of the day was £40,000 for a 2022 Kelberg tri axle bulk tipping trailer.


The best of the vehicles made £14,500 for a 2016 Isuzu Blade with 73,000 miles on the clock. A JCB 8080 digger having done 5,400 hours made £10,900.

A Keenan mech fibre 320 diet feeder to £4,800, closely followed by a 2014 Teagle 8100 trailed straw chopper to £4,200 and an Ifor Williams tri axle trailer to £3,600.

A Dalbo auto reset cultivator to £3,050, a 2012 BVL 15 cubic metre twin auger diet feeder to £3,000 and a 2016 Pottinger single rotor rake to £2,950.


